

City View Equestrian Hunter Prize List

Hunter in Hand

To be judged on conformation and hunter movement in hand. Horses must enter 2 of the 3 classes to be considered for Champion and Reserve. Movement and Conformation to be judged on the Hunter Jumper standard. "Handlers will be asked to jog horses in hand to show movement to judge. Handlers will be asked to set their horse in a model position to be judged.

- 1) Hunter 3 years and under – 2 and 3 year olds must be shown in bridle
- 2) Hunter Broodmares –Mares only. Must be shown in bridle
- 3) Overall Open Hunter –All ages and sexes. Horses over the age of 2 must be shown in bridle.
Must enter to qualify for champion and Reserve.

Level 1 Hunters

2'3" Open to horses and ponies. Professionals may enter. Green Horse and Cross Rail division riders may NOT enter.

Level 2 Hunter

2'6" Open to horses and ponies. Professionals may enter. Green Horse and Cross Rail division riders may NOT enter.

Level Equitation

2'6" Open to horses and ponies. Professionals may enter. Green Horse and Cross Rail division riders may NOT enter.

Level 3 Hunters

2'9" Open to horses and ponies. Professionals may enter. Green Horse and Cross Rail division riders may NOT enter.

Hack Division

Open to horses and ponies. Open to all riders, including Professionals. Riders will be asked to walk, trot and canter in both directions. Canter sections will be split pending size of classes.

Green Rider Walk/Trot

Open to **beginner** riders of all ages. May NOT enter any other divisions. Professionals may not enter.

Cross Rails

Open to all amateur riders. Green horses may enter, but professionals may not. Riders may not cross enter into any other classes except hack division.

Green Horse Cross Rails

Open to horses and ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing. Professionals may enter.

Baby Green

Open to horses and ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing. Professionals may enter. Green Cross Rail horses may enter. Fences set at 2'.


Leadline

Open to all children and adults incapable of riding a horse without a handler. Riders may be asked questions by the judge. Riders comfortable with trotting will be asked to perform. Other riders may walk during the trot section. Riders will be asked to demonstrate a 2-point position and be led over a pole.

Rules and Regulations

- “Level” riders may not enter into any “Green” or “Cross Rail” divisions
 - Professionals may enter in any “Level” divisions, including Equitation
 - Professionals may enter into Baby Green and Green Horse Cross Rails
 - Horses entered into “Level” divisions may not cross enter into Green Horse classes
 - Cross Rail riders may not cross enter into “Level” classes
1. Full payment for class fees and stabling must accompany entries. Cash or Checks will be accepted. No credit cards. A \$50.00 surcharge will be added to all checks returned from the bank, regardless of reason. Additionally, exhibitors are encouraged to leave an open check at the horse show office to cover added classes. Otherwise, classes must be paid for as they are added.
 2. Any accounts not paid in full by the end of the show will be assessed a \$30.00 billing fee.
 3. Schooling trips will be unlimited (within reason) for \$10 a trip. **No ticket, no trip.**
 4. **Formal attire.** Jackets may be removed upon Judge’s approval.
 5. Very limited stabling available. Stalls will be sold first come, first serve. PLEASE CALL IN ADVANCE TO BOOK STALLS. Will sell left overs day of show.
 6. Bedding will be available day of show for an additional \$7 per bag. No bedding will be provided in stalls.
 7. No overnight stabling provided.
 8. No tack stalls may be purchased.
 9. **Refunds:** Registrations withdrawn 1 week prior to the show date will be refunded in full. Registrations withdrawn morning of show date will have class fees and warm up fees refunded.
 10. Proof of rabies vaccination, dated within 12 months of arrival on show grounds, and negative coggins test results, dated 2016 or 2017, should accompany entries and payment. In addition, horses stabled outside New York state must submit a valid Health Certificate dated within 30 days. No numbers will be issued until health papers are submitted. Health papers will not be returned. Do not send originals.
 11. THERE WILL BE A \$1.00 PER PAGE CHARGE TO COPY HEALTH PAPERS IN THE HORSE SHOW OFFICE.
 12. All riders are required to wear a helmet with a harness securely fastened that meet or exceed ASTM/SEI F1163 standards whenever mounted.
 13. Riding in the barns is prohibited.
 14. Anyone mounted without a helmet will be asked to leave the grounds – no warnings.
 15. City View Equestrian, LLC and its employees/volunteers will not be responsible for any injury, loss or damage incurred to riders, observers, horses, or equipment brought to this show. All riders are at their own risk.
 16. Each horse/rider combination requires a separate entry number.
 17. High Points are awarded based on the entry number. Champion and Reserve prizes and ribbons will be awarded in all divisions in which 5 or more entries compete in a majority of the classes.
 18. Horses may arrive at the show grounds after 6am on day of show. The indoor arena will be open at 6am for schooling. The show arena will be open at 7am for schooling and close at 8:30am to prep for the first class.

19. Management reserves the right to limit the number of horses in the show/schooling arenas at one time.
 20. **There will be no lunging of horses in any of the arenas.**
 21. Riders under 18 are not allowed to ride stallions.
 22. Weather delays will only be held until 11am on scheduled day of show. Show will be canceled if class #1 does not start before 11am. Rain dates will be posted.
 23. The decision to divide, combine, move or cancel a class will be at the discretion of show management. Management reserves the right to combine or cancel classes with less than 6 entries. Classes will be split at the discretion of show management.
 24. Bedding may be purchased through Mary Corke (585)386-9338. Please include additional bedding fees on entry forms.
 25. **No dogs on the property**
 26. Trailer parking will be determined by parking assistants. Parking available in large, grass field at BACK of property, passed the show arena. No parking by the barns or houses will be permitted. Parking on the road is discouraged.
