According to Shoreman, the best part of the crossing was the end. "The fog was rolling onto the lake from the shoreline, so I couldn't see the shore through the crossing until the last 40 minutes, and when I saw the lighthouse and people standing there waving it was very emotional. Some walked with me back down the pier as I made my way to the beach to make the arrival, and [the people] were talking with me which was really nice," he says.

I asked Shoreman what words of encouragement he would offer to someone struggling with a disability, and he responded, "I would suggest to anyone struggling with their disabilities or their mental health to lean in on their network or community. Ask for help, ask for support, and be grateful for the ones who want to help you."

When I asked Shoreman if there was anything else he'd like to share, he said, "I am so grateful for the love received in Wisconsin and Minnesota. I am a Canadian and wasn't sure how this would be received, and have been

very moved by how Americans are supporting me and the mental health of young people in crisis. I am grateful to the owners of the Beach Resort in Herbster, Wisconsin for housing me and my teams and all the amazing people from Wisconsin and Minnesota who helped me. Thank you!"
