## **SEPTEMBER 13, 2018 MEETING MINUTES - Tim Horn**

Location: FHUSD Learning Center in Fountain Hills, AZ

7:02PM, Call to Order, Nancy Ordowski, LD23 Chair

Prayer - CT Wright, PC; Pledge of Allegiance - Jim O'Connor, LD23 Past Chair

- 1. Introductions of LD23 ExCom: Nancy
- Introductions of elected officials in attendance, Nancy: (Michelle Ugenti-Rita, state legislator, Sheila Muehling, MCR Treasurer, Judy Rutkowski, Fountain Hills School Board, Bob Lettieri, AZGOP Treasurer, Jay Lawrence, AZ state legislator, among those in Attendance)
- 3. Introductions of new PCs, candidates and other guests: Nancy
- 4. Comments re: issues for Republicans and LD23, Nancy: The MCR is about to provide "Golden Tickets" for distribution which will reflect the GOP slate for the November 6 midterm election, however Federal candidates not included for legal reasons. There were many problems with the midterm election. These were documented from LD23 PCs at the polls and reported to Maricopa County Board of Supervisors Chairman Chucri. He has been lobbied by T. Horn and others to retake control of elections back from the Democrat Recorder. It was reported that at a recent GOP meeting, Chucri announced that this was imminent.
- 5. Sign Up: a sheet was passed to sign up for poll working and watching. The volunteer number is 602-506-3535.

- 6. Issues on the November 6 ballot were discussed in general by Jonathan Paton of the Arizona Free Enterprise Club; Lynndy Smith spoke on Prop 127; Question #1 was discussed and is supported by Scottsdale City Council members Guy Phillips and Kathy Littlefield: Prop 420 was discussed by Betty Janick & Jason Alexander from "Protect Our Preserve" A primer on ballot issues: Look at the first number. A "1"= designates a proposed amendment to the AZ Constitution; "2" = Citizen Initiative; "3" = from state legislature; "4"= a local issue. Issues & recommended votes, as they will appear on MCR Golden Ticket: **125**= YES (changes pension from defined benefit to defined contribution for AZ Corrections Officers to overcome underfunding); 126= NO (limits future preferential application of the transaction privilege tax on services) ; 127= NO (to block government energy mandates which would increase our energy costs); 305=YES (will allow legislature-approved expansion of educational empowerment scholarships); 306= YES (would prohibit candidates from transferring Clean Election funds to political parties or PACs, a tactic frequently used by DEMS to redirect public funds); 420= YES ( presented by Scottsdale "Protect our Preserve" activists Betty Janick and Jason Alexander, will not allow physical development of the McDowell Mountain Sonoran Preserve); Question 1(Scottsdale)= YES (will permit Scottsdale to acquire transportation money for specific projects that will become unavailable).
- 7. Candidate speakers:

**Rory Van Poucke** a Conservative also requests our support for Kerry Giangobbe, April Pinger, & Lisa Atkins to block Dem control of CAP Water Board; Jim O'Connor for **Kathleen Winn** for Maricopa County Community College District Board; **Aaron Flannery** for his candidacy for Maricopa County Recorder in 2020.

- 9. Michael Loverine was selected by Nancy as Chairman of the Nominating Committee for the November 29 Organizational Meeting. Ted Green, Linda Rizzo, Candace Mann and Larry Hagan were nominated from the floor as additional members of the Nominating Committee. All were approved by acclamation and without any dissent.

 Congratulations to: Michelle Ugenti-Rita for election as State Senator and to her LD23 opponents; Jim O'Connor for a fine campaign in achieving number 3 in the Corporation Commission election; Jay Lawrence and John Kavanagh in their nominations for the two State Legislature positions.
