



**FILEY : A close up view of the boulder clay / glacial till. This material was eroded by ice sheets during the ice age and transported south as moraine to be deposited here in present day Yorkshire.**

**It is a mixture of clay and boulders. The boulders are unsorted, angular and consist of a wide variety of rock types derived from areas eroded by the ice.**

**It is easily weathered, affected by sub-aerial processes and eroded by waves.**
