Aaron Stump, Indiana Wildlife Federation, "Wild-life Friendly Habitat Workshop"

Program participants will learn about native plants and animals, explore the links between their communities and larger ecosystems, and discover how to create a wildlife-friendly habitat. The Indiana Wildlife Federation, state affiliate of the National Wildlife Federation, developed this course to connect homeowners as well as property owners and managers to nature in a fun and educational way.

**Susan MiHalo, Conservation Coordinator for The Nature Conservancy,
Managing Invasive Species in Your Neighborhood: Where Do You Start?**

Susan MiHalo has been a Conservation Coordinator for The Nature Conservancy (TNC), Southern Lake Michigan Rim Project Office, Merrillville, IN since August 2012. She is responsible for outreach efforts and programming in Northwest Indiana to help achieve TNC's mission to conserve the lands and waters on which all life depends. Susan also assists with day-to-day management of the Merrillville office, helps coordinate the Indiana Coastal Cooperative Weed Management area on behalf of its Steering Committee, and recently completed a project funded by the Lake Michigan Coastal Program to improve early detection of invasive species in the area. She has spoken to more than 1,000 people about invasive species and how people can help overcome them.

Susan is a past president and board member of Save the Dunes and has served on the Board of Directors of the Alliance for the Great Lakes. She has more than 30 years of nonprofit management and communications experience.
