Request For Proposal #02-2019 For Medical and Mental Health Services Addendum #2

We have received questions from a prospective Vendor in reference to the RFP #02-2019. The questions and answers are listed below.

Ouestions

Following are some questions from CMC about this RFP:

- 1. Can the Jail give us an idea of how many hours of coverage you are seeking from each the Physician, Psychiatrist, and Qualified Mental Health Professional?
- 2. Does the Jail currently have a medical director? Or is the physician the contractor provides expected to function as such? We need clarification on this since the two positions involve different responsibilities.
- 3. Is the Jail considering fully outsourcing its medical and mental health programs in the future?
- 4. May we have a full, up to date staffing matrix for the medical and mental health staff currently working in the facility?

Responses

- 1. The Southside Regional Authority is seeking a Physician to provide care and to see inmates twice monthly. We are seeking a Psychiatrist to see inmates one hour weekly. The (QMHP) Qualified Mental Health Professional is required to work 24 hours weekly.
- 2. The Southside Regional Jail's Physician will function as the Medical Director. We have a Licensed Practical Nurse that is the head of the Medical Department and she supervises 2 EMTs (Emergency Medical Technicians).
- 3. No, the Southside Regional Jail is not considering fully outsourcing our medical and mental health programs in the future.
- 4. The Southside Regional Jail currently has (1) LPN that is in charge of the Medical Department, we have 2 EMT's that are supervised by the LPN.

The Physician, Psychiatrist and QMHP are staffed through contract with our current Medical Provider.
