

Learning to sew is fun! Sewing is not only a useful skill to have, but it is also a creative outlet that can provide many enjoyable hours of productivity and increased knowledge about how to assemble clothing and other projects.

Classes are limited to 6 students per session. All materials and tools will be provided for student use for Sewing Class 1 and Sewing Class 2. Students who desire to enroll in Sewing Class 3 and higher should bring their own supplies* and a portable sewing machine.

Sewing Class 1 - \$25.00 (60 min. class)

Learn the names and uses of basic sewing tools

Sew by hand using needle and thread

Basic stitches and knots

Attaching a button

Use a simple pattern

Cut fabric (using pins and scissors safely and effectively)

Create a Level One take-home project

Sewing Class 2 - \$35.00 (90 min. class)

Review of hand sewing and sewing tools/terminology

Use an iron safely and properly

Learn how to thread and use a sewing machine

Create a Level Two take-home project

Level One take-home projects may include:

Fabric flower adorned elastic headband

Felt flower hair clip

Level Two take-home projects may include:

Decorative pillow

Cinch backpack
Drawstring bag

Level Three take-home projects may include:

An apron
A tote bag

*Sewing kit supply list:

Comfortable, sharp fabric shears

Small thread-snippers (optional)

1 spool of white thread

Measuring tape

Pins (the ones with the colored balls on the ends work best)

Seam ripper
