## **Campaign Awards**

The NFRW Campaign Volunteer Award Form is due to AzFRW Campaign Chair by June 1<sup>st</sup>. ALL our Arizona club volunteer hours combined make up the aggregate total that AzFRW then submits to NFRW for recognition for our state. The NFRW form will also serve as your club's submission of hours for the AzFRW State Convention. ### **Caring for America**

From the applications received, AzFRW may choose only one project to submit to NFRW. As with Campaign Awards, the NFRW Caring for America form will also be used to submit your club's project for AzFRW awards recognition. **Use the NFRW form, submit to AzFRW President by June 1**<sup>st</sup>.

### **Public Relations**

The NFRW Public Relations form is due to AzFRW President by no later than June 1st.

From the applications received, AzFRW may chose only one project to submit to NFRW for AZ.

As with Caring and Campaigns, the NFRW form will also be used as your club's entry form to submit Public Relations achievements for AzFRW Convention awards recognition. Although we may submit only one project to NFRW, Arizona recognize various outstanding projects at our State Convention in October.
