The upstairs will consist of a 50 ft x 60 ft. open area to be used as an air gun range. The downstairs will be able to be sectioned off for three concurrent classes. The price tag is now up to \$1.5 million and the scope has increased to 6,500 sf. The next step in the process is to take the concept drawings to the county planners for approval.
