OPEN OFFICER POSITIONS



SAINT OF THE MONTH

ALBERT THE GREAT

Bishop and Doctor (1206-1289)

A German Dominican who influenced the Church's stance toward Aristotelian philosophy. Known as the teacher of Thomas Aquinas, who developed a synthesis of Greek wisdom and Christian theology, Albert is described as an honest and diligent scholar.

In 1263 <u>Pope Urban IV</u> relieved him of the duties of bishop of Regensburg and asked him to preach the eighth Crusade in German-speaking countries.

Albert's writings collected in 1899 went to thirty-eight volumes. These displayed his prolific habits and encyclopedic knowledge.

He digested, interpreted, and systematized the whole of Aristotle's works in accordance with Church doctrine. Most modern knowledge of Aristotle was preserved and presented by Albert.

His principal theological works are a commentary in three volumes on the Books of the Sentences of <u>Peter Lombard</u> (*Magister Sententiarum*), and the <u>Summa Theologiae</u> in two volumes.

Albert was <u>beatified</u> in 1622. He was <u>canonized</u> and proclaimed a Doctor of the Church on December 16, 1931, by <u>Pope Pius XI</u> and the patron saint of natural scientists in 1941. St. Albert's <u>feast day</u> is November 15.
