

To enter your Art & Craft items to the Fair, follow the steps below.

- Read the Entry Requirements:
Here you will find information regarding turn in dates, fees and the general rules for Fair Entry. It is your responsibility to follow the Entry Requirements.
- If you are entering items in Culinary, Fine Art, Floriculture or Photography:
Be sure to read the requirements for those departments. These items **are in addition to** the general entry requirements.

Once you are familiar with the Entry Requirements; if you are comfortable working online you may move directly to the entry process, at <http://vvfair.fairwire.com> see **online** notes below. If you are using a paper entry or want more information before going online, follow these steps:

- Choose the appropriate Department from the list below:
Example, Culinary (all things food)
- In each department are divisions:
Example, Quick Breads, Yeast Breads, Cakes, etc.
- Each division will have levels:
Example, Adult, Teen, Youth
- and Classes which are the specific item in the division:
Example, Yeast Breads Adult, Rolls.

- Note the Department, Division and Class for each item you are entering.
You may enter multiple departments and you may enter multiple divisions and classes in each department, however; there is a limit of 2 items per class unless noted otherwise.
