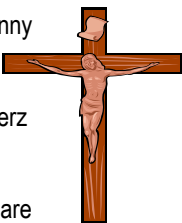

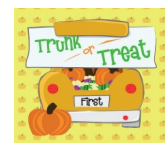


Catholic Stewardship Appeal 2019

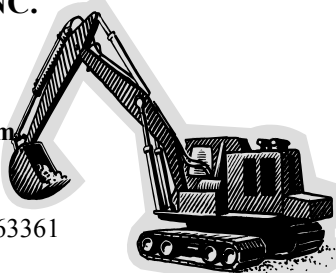
