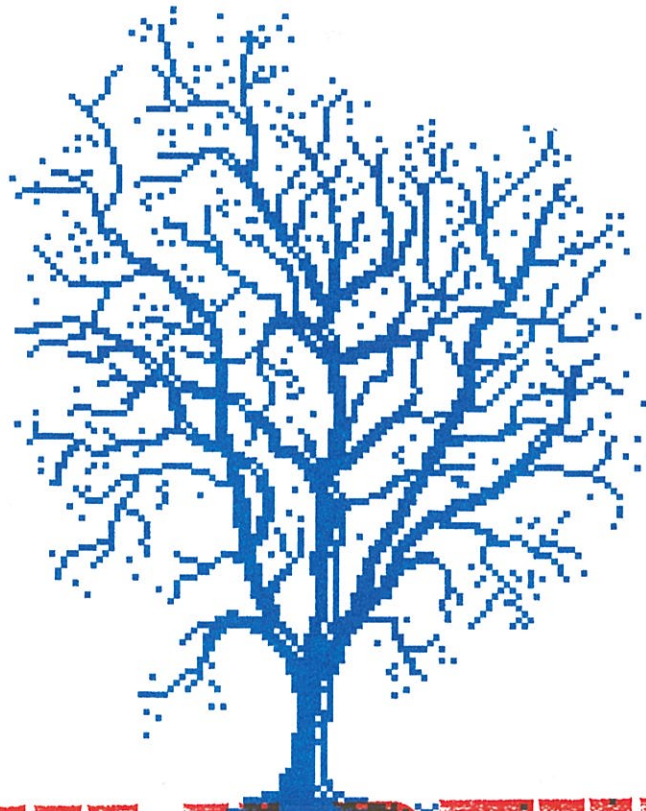

A Brugger Family Story

The following words represent the collective memories of several people as well as documented events found in newspapers, family bibles, letters, pictures etc. Sondra (Sissy) Beatty Palmer furnished much of the early information on the Bruggers. The genealogical record keeping and organizational structure of this document were maintained using a computer program called Family Tree Maker. The database supporting the program can be made available to anyone. As with any history, there is often conflict with regard to spelling of names. German names were translated to English, and sometimes letters were dropped, omitted, or changed. It was often difficult to tell if you are looking at the German spelling or the English spelling. Family Tree Maker requires that only one spelling be used.

The oldest person listed in the family history is Theresia Brugger, born in 1754. Theresia was the mother of Michael Brugger, born in 1772, and Michael was the father of George Brugger, born in 1828. George was the father of Sigmund Brugger. This information came from Erwin Meir, whose grandfather was Josef Brugger, brother of Sigmund. Our history of the Bruggers in America begins with Sigmund and Katharina.

Richard Brugger, brother of Sigmund, came to the United States before 1888. His wife was Anna M. Hilby. They were married in Hannibal, MO on January 11, 1888. There is a family sheet on Richard and Annie and their nine children included in this history. They moved to Springfield about 1891. Their first two children were born in Hannibal and the other seven were born in Springfield. Richard wrote to Sigmund in Germany, asking him to come to Springfield to live.

Sigmund and Katharina (Sayers (Saeirs)) Brugger, with baby Theresia, came to the United States and Missouri sometime in

1893. We could not find in the local Springfield library any records relating to them arriving in the United States. It is believed they entered through New York but it could have been Philadelphia.

A second daughter, Karolina, may have been born on-board the ship on the way to the United States. There is no record of her death. The third daughter, Maria (Mary) and the fourth, Florence, were born on South Jefferson near Jarrett school. This early family picture is when Florence was a baby and includes Mary, about 4, Theresa about 6, Sigmund and Katharina.



Louise, Frances (Fanny), Carl and Margarete were born on Lynn Street near Kansas Avenue, and Josephine was born on

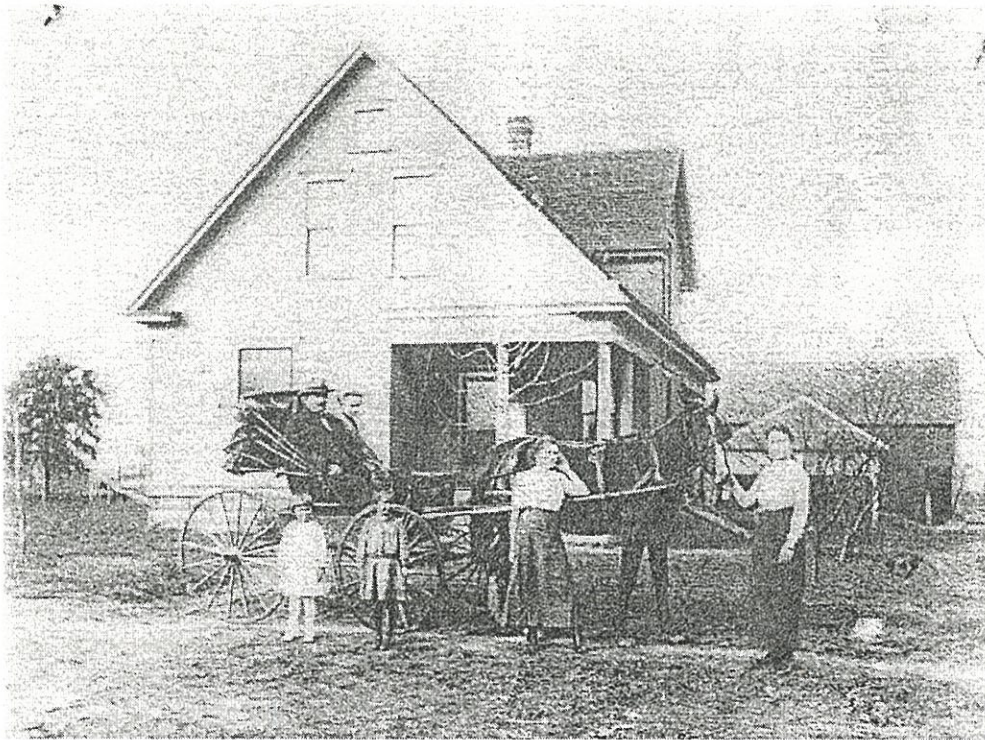
Calhoun Street in what was later known as the Brugger homeplace. Catherine Smith, daughter of Theresa and Vincent, lives in that home today.



Another sister, Lina Rosaminda (who would have been number five), was born and died in 1899. Records suggest that she is buried in St. Mary's cemetery in Springfield.

In September 1906, Sigmund became a citizen of the United States. Included in this book is a copy of the original Certificate of Citizenship on file at the Greene County archives. In those days, when a husband became a citizen, the wife and children also became citizens.

In 1908, Mother Katharina had a stroke and was sick for about 5 years. In her later years, she was bedfast. She died of a brain tumor on September 6, 1913. Florence was about 17, Mary was 20, and Theresa was 22. Josephine, the youngest child, was about five years old. On the day she died, a picture was taken of Theresa as she boarded a buggy to go to the store to select her wedding dress. This picture, which includes Sigmund, Mary, Florence, Louise, and Fanny, was taken at the family homeplace on Calhoun Street. Theresa was married on January 17, 1914.



Sigmund owned the Palace Saloon, located on Commercial Street near Lyon Avenue. This picture shows the saloon and the workers. It must have been a good business to employ four

workers. Sigmund may also have owned or worked in the Kirby Arcade, located near Heer's, for a number of years.



On July 30, 1916, in a group known as the German Singers, while traveling to sing at a picnic in Golden City, MO, Sigmund was killed in an automobile accident. Accounts from two newspapers reporting the death are contained in this book. At the time of his death, Theresa, Mary, and Florence were married. Theresa and Vincent took over the responsibility of raising the remaining Brugger children.

If anyone has more complete information that should be added to our family history, I would appreciate a copy of it. I hope to add to this book through the years if possible.

CERTIFICATE OF CITIZENSHIP

UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.

STATE OF MISSOURI, County of Greene In the Circuit Court, 1916 Term, 1916

BE IT REMEMBERED, That on the 15th day of September in the year of our Lord One Thousand Nine Hundred and 16 personally appeared before the Hon. W. H. C. [Name] Judge of the Circuit Court of the County of Greene and State aforesaid (the same being a Court of Record, having and exercising common law jurisdiction, a Justices a Clerk), sitting judicially for the dispatch of business, at the Court House in the City of Warrensburg in the County aforesaid, Christian [Name] an alien, of lawful age, and applied to the said Court to be naturalized to become a Naturalized Citizen of the United States of America, pursuant to the several Acts of Congress heretofore passed on that subject. And the said alien having thereupon produced to the Court recent testimony showing that he has heretofore resided in this State, and filed his declaration of his intention to become a citizen of the United States, according to the provisions of the said several Acts of Congress, and the Court being satisfied as well from the oath of the said alien, as from the affidavit filed and the testimony taken of W. H. C. [Name] and W. H. C. [Name] that the said alien has resided within the limits and under the jurisdiction of the United States for at least one year last past within the State of Missouri; that during the whole of that time he has behaved himself as a man of good moral character, attached to the principles contained in the Constitution of the United States, and well disposed to the good order and happiness of the same; and that he is not opposed to all organized government, and is not a member of or affiliated with any organization, external and teaching such doctrine in or opposition to all organized government, or who advocates or teaches the duty, secret or property of the unlawful assaulting or killing of any officer or officers, either of specific individuals or of the Government of the United States, or of any other organized government, because of his or its official character; that he has not knowingly aided or abetted, or conspired or conspired with any person or persons to allow, procure or permit any alien who is an idiot, an insane person, or one who has been declared insane by lawful authority within five years previous to his arrival, or one who has epilepsy, or one who is a pauper, or who is likely to become a public charge or a professional beggar, to enter the United States, or any territory subject to the jurisdiction thereof; that he has not landed, or permitted to be landed, any alien, at any other time or place than that designated by the Immigration officers of the United States; that he has not by himself or another, brought, landed as imported, or attempted to bring, and as import into the United States any alien who is afflicted with a loathsome or dangerous contagious disease, or one who has been convicted of a felony or other crime or misdemeanor involving moral turpitude, or one who is a polygamist, or any woman or girl for the purpose of prostitution; that he has not held or attempted to hold any woman or girl for the purpose of prostitution in pursuance of such illegal importation; that he has not aided or abetted the importation of any person or persons in violation of the terms of the Contract Labor Laws of the United States, and that he has not violated any provision of an Act of Congress entitled "An Act to regulate the immigration of aliens into the United States," approved March 3, 1903; and the said affidavit reading and affirming the truth of every material fact requisite for naturalization, having been read and approved by the Court, and the said alien having in open Court taken and subscribed the oath required by law to support the Constitution of the United States, and to renounce and abjure all allegiance and fidelity to every foreign Prince, Emperor, State or Sovereign, and particularly all allegiance which he was in anywise due to any such foreign Prince, Emperor, State or Sovereign, and to have thereby admitted a Citizen of the United States, whereof he was heretofore a subject.

IT IS THEREUPON CONSIDERED, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED BY THE COURT, That the said Christian [Name] be and he is hereby admitted a Citizen of the United States.

STATE OF MISSOURI, County of Greene W. H. C. [Name] Clerk of the Circuit Court within and for the County of Greene certify the foregoing to be a true transcript of the order of said Court, looking the naturalization of Christian [Name] as the same now remains of record in my office.

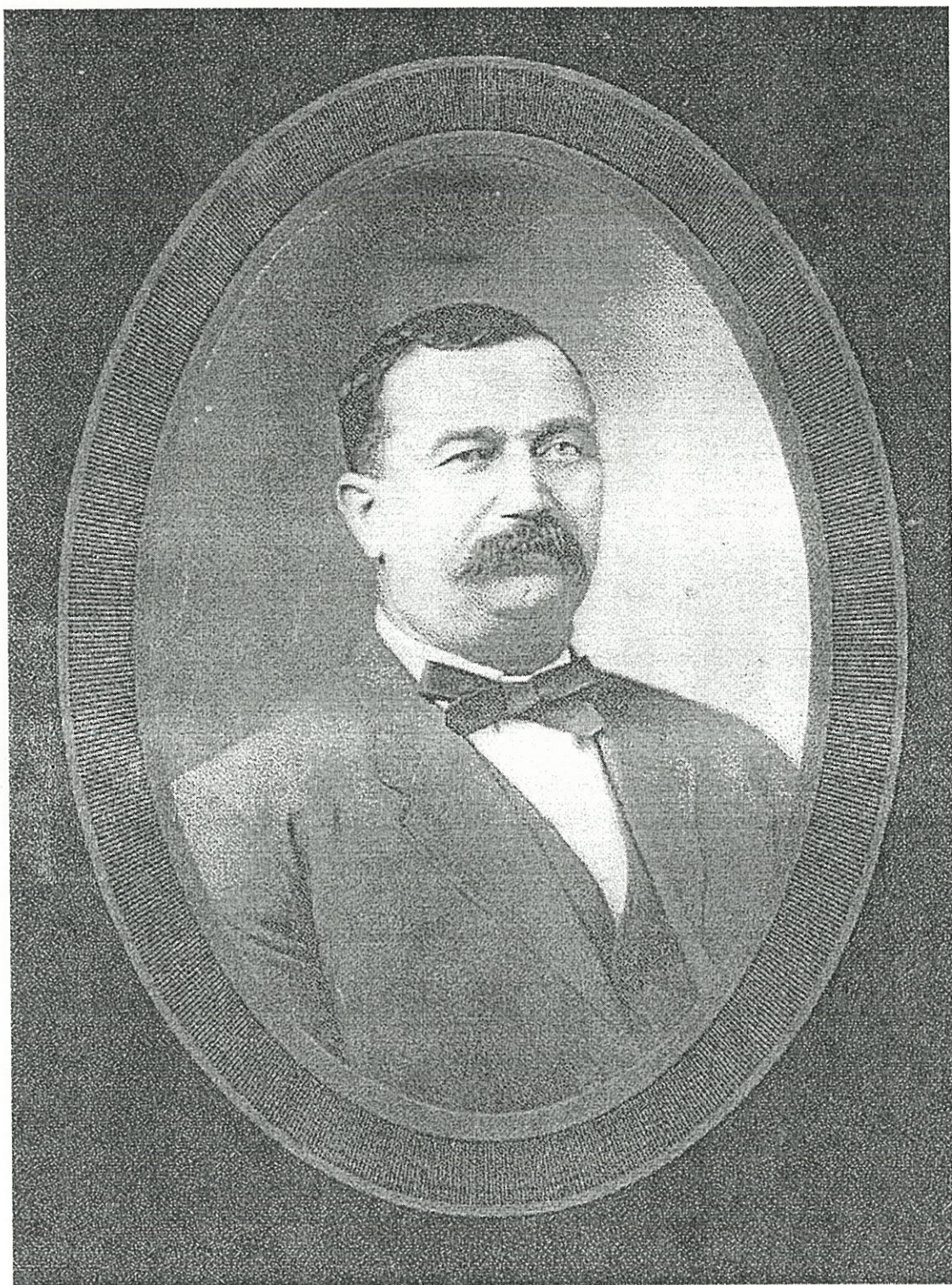

SIGMUND BRUGGER PINNED BENEATH AUTO AND KILLED

FOUR OTHERS ARE BADLY INJURED

Death Rides With Party Of Spring-
field German Singers Enroute
To Picnic At Golden City.

TRAGEDY NEAR GREENFIELD

George Schuerer, Joseph Dieter-
man, J. Jakley and John Braig,
Other Occupants Of Car, Hurt.

Pinned beneath an automobile of which he had lost control, Sigmund Brugger, aged 50 years, proprietor of the Palace saloon, was almost instantly killed at 8:45 o'clock yesterday morning about a quarter of a mile west of Greenfield. The victim was a member of a party of men composing an organization known as the German singers, which was enroute to Golden City, to spend the day on a picnic. Following are the injured: George Schuerer, plumber, of 330 Smith street, right leg badly bruised; Joseph Dieterman, tailor, 524 West State street, three ribs fractured and severe bruises; J. Jakley, tailor, left shoulder bruised; John Braig, cigarmaker, 448 1-2 West Division street, internally injured.

In an automobile immediately behind the machine owned and driven by Mr. Brugger, was Charles Summerfield, proprietor of the Summerfield Floral company, with other members of the singing society. Mr. Summerfield's party rushed to the aid of the occupants of the wrecked automobile, placing them in the car and returning with them to Greenfield. There they were given treatment and cared for until 5 o'clock yesterday afternoon, when they returned to Springfield by rail.

The two automobiles carrying the picnickers left Springfield at 5 o'clock yesterday morning enroute for Golden City. Mr. Brugger with his Overland car was in the lead, Mr. Summerfield following. In his car were Herman F. Lohmeyer, John Matt, Mike Zay, Lorenz Gelsheimer, Frank Englekling and Mr. Ribniker. Other members of the Singers went to Golden City by rail. According to Mr. Summerfield, both cars made good time until Greenfield was reached. Passing through Greenfield, they were progressing along a good stretch of road at a speed of about 25 miles per hour. About 300 yards ahead of the Summerfield car was the Brugger machine. Mr. Summerfield keeping about that distance in the rear to avoid the dust.

Second Car To Rescue.

Suddenly, stated Mr. Summerfield this morning, the car ahead began to zigzag dangerously, careening from one side of the road to the other, apparently beyond control. Then the machine turned turtle and in a cloud of dust rolled over and over, coming to a standstill in an upright position at right angles to the road. All that could be seen when the car capsize was the sides of the car in the air, turning over and over.

Mr. Summerfield speeded up his car and arrived on the scene within a few seconds. Every occupant of the ill-fated machine was lying on the ground in an unconscious condition, all clear of the car with the exception of Mr. Braig, who was pinned beneath one of the wheels. Mr. Brugger was lying on the ground, face upward. His eyes were rushed out. His lips were moving, but he made no sound. He died within two minutes. Mr. Dieterman sustained three fractured ribs. He was reclining near Mr. Brugger, and blood was running from his nose and ears. Messrs. Schuerer and Jakley regained consciousness when they were moved. By the time they had

been placed in Mr. Summerfield's machine, all had regained consciousness, Mr. Braig being able to climb into the machine unassisted. All were hurried to Greenfield, the former occupants of Mr. Summerfield's car remaining with Mr. Brugger's body at the scene of the accident.

Attended at Greenfield. When the automobile containing the injured members arrived in Greenfield some trouble was experienced in finding a place where they could be cared for. The proprietor of one hotel had refused to take them in, claiming he had no quarters for them. They were finally taken to the Washington hotel. When they reached the history every member of the injured party had again lapsed into unconsciousness, it being necessary to carry them to their rooms. Several physicians had arrived by this time and they soon revived the injured men. Their wounds were dressed and they remained in bed until yesterday afternoon, when they boarded a Frisco passenger train for Springfield. They arrived here about 6:30 o'clock, Mr. Brugger's body being on the same train. Mr. Braig was forced to sit in a seat in the chair car, owing to the fact that a stretcher was not available. Upon his arrival, he was taken at once to the St. John's hospital. This morning his condition was said to be satisfactory. Other members of the party also rested well last night and no serious complications are expected to develop from their injuries.

With the exception of Mr. Jakley, every member of the injured party was crushed beneath the touring car when it went over. The men were thrown in front of the car and were caught before they could escape. When he felt the car starting to capsize, Mr. Jakley jumped and evaded being struck. He sustained the injured shoulder when he struck the ground.

Mr. Brugger's body was taken in charge by Will C. Lohmeyer, undertaker, and is being prepared for burial. The decedent was a widower, being survived by eight children, seven daughters and one son. They are Mrs. Teresa Smith, Mrs. Mary Beatty and Mrs. Florence Horton, all of whom reside in Springfield, and Misses Louise, Frances, Marguerite and Josephine Brugger, of the home address. Carl Brugger, the son, also resides at the home.

Funeral services will be conducted from the home at 9 o'clock tomorrow morning, followed by interment in the St. Mary's cemetery.

AUTO WRECKED; ONE KILLED, FOUR HURT

Sigmund Brugger Meets Death When Machine Overturns While He and Companions Are On Way To Picnic.

The funeral of Sigmund Brugger, proprietor of the Palace saloon, who was instantly killed at 1:45 o'clock Sunday morning when an Overland automobile he was driving turned turtle near Greenfield, will be held from the family residence, 1407 West Calhoun street, at 10 o'clock this morning. Interment will be in St. Mary's cemetery.

Brugger, who was 35 years old, was fearfully maimed in the accident, which caused injuries to four other persons who were in the machine with him. He received a severe compound fracture of the skull, a broken neck, fracture of the left jaw bone, a broken nose and numerous cuts and bruises about the head and face. The other persons injured were: George Schuerer, a plumber of 138 Smith street; Joseph Deltzman, a tailor who resides at 114 West State street; J. Jakley, also a tailor, and John Braig, a widely known cigarmaker who resides at 443 1/2 West Division street.

Loss Control of Car.

Brugger had started early Sunday morning to Golden City with a party of German singers who were to attend a picnic there. At a point about a quarter of a mile west of Greenfield he lost control of his automobile, which was running about 20 miles an hour. He attempted to right the car, but his sudden jerk on the steering bar caused the wreck which cost his life. The car turned over and the occupants, with the exception of Jakley, were pinned beneath the machine.

Charles Summerfield of the Summerfield Floral company, drove a car immediately behind Brugger's. With him were Herman F. Lohnmeyer, John West, Mike Zav, Lorenz Gelsheimer and Frank Enaleking.

When Mr. Summerfield and his party saw the ill-fated Brugger car whirl down before them they increased speed and rushed to the aid of the occupants of the front car. When they reached the scene all the Brugger party were unconscious. In passing they passed beneath the front of the steering wheel which still lay across his face. The machine was quickly raised and the victims dragged from beneath. They were placed in the Summerfield car, which party stayed with the body of Brugger, the injured were taken to Greenfield for treatment. They were kept in a hotel there until they could be brought to Springfield, at 4:30 and while the remainder of the Sunday. Brugger's body was brought here on the same train.

Jakley Leaps to Safety.

Mr. Deltzman sustained fractures to three of his ribs and is possibly injured internally. Braig is suffering from severe cuts and bruises, but it was not believed yesterday that he was injured internally. He was removed to St. John's hospital. ment books or his or her assessment; that must be in the office of the assessor, or he or she must have paid a license tax of a poll tax to the city of Springfield prior to the current year.

"b. The qualifying clause, 'owning property in the block or square in which the dramshop is to be kept,' applies to minors only and not to the other class of assessed tax-paying citizens.

"c. Property owned by a minor in the block may be either real or personal.

"d. A citizen may be either a man or a woman.

"e. A majority of such class is not required.

Those Ineligible to Sign.

Third. Qualification of signers. Who are qualified signers?

"1. Temporary guests, rooming or boarding in the block.

"2. Stockholders of corporations located in a block, as the corporation itself is a legal entity, separate and distinct from the stockholders and hence the property of a corporation is corporate property and assessed as such.

"3. A citizen residing outside of the city who owns property in the block and regularly assessed.

"Fourth. All persons of the block qualified to sign the saloon petition, whose names do not appear on the petition, should be counted as being opposed to the issuing of the license, whether on the remonstrance or not.

"Fifth. The order of the council entered of record issuing a license must state that all the necessary prerequisites required by law have been complied with the applicant and that the proper petition with the required number of names attached

thereto has been filed with the application. In short, the order must show all the necessary jurisdictional facts."

Peach Shipments Have Reached 108 Carloads

Peach shipments, in carload lots from points on the Frisco system so far this season have totaled 108 cars, according to the latest reports received in the office of the department of development of the railroad yesterday. Last year at this time 144 cars had been shipped. No express shipments have been made.

So far this season 111 carloads of watermelons have been shipped from points on the Frisco, as compared with 587 cars last year. Only 10 cars of cantaloupes have been shipped so far this year as compared with 12 last year. All of the green fruit shipments of the department are much below those of last year.

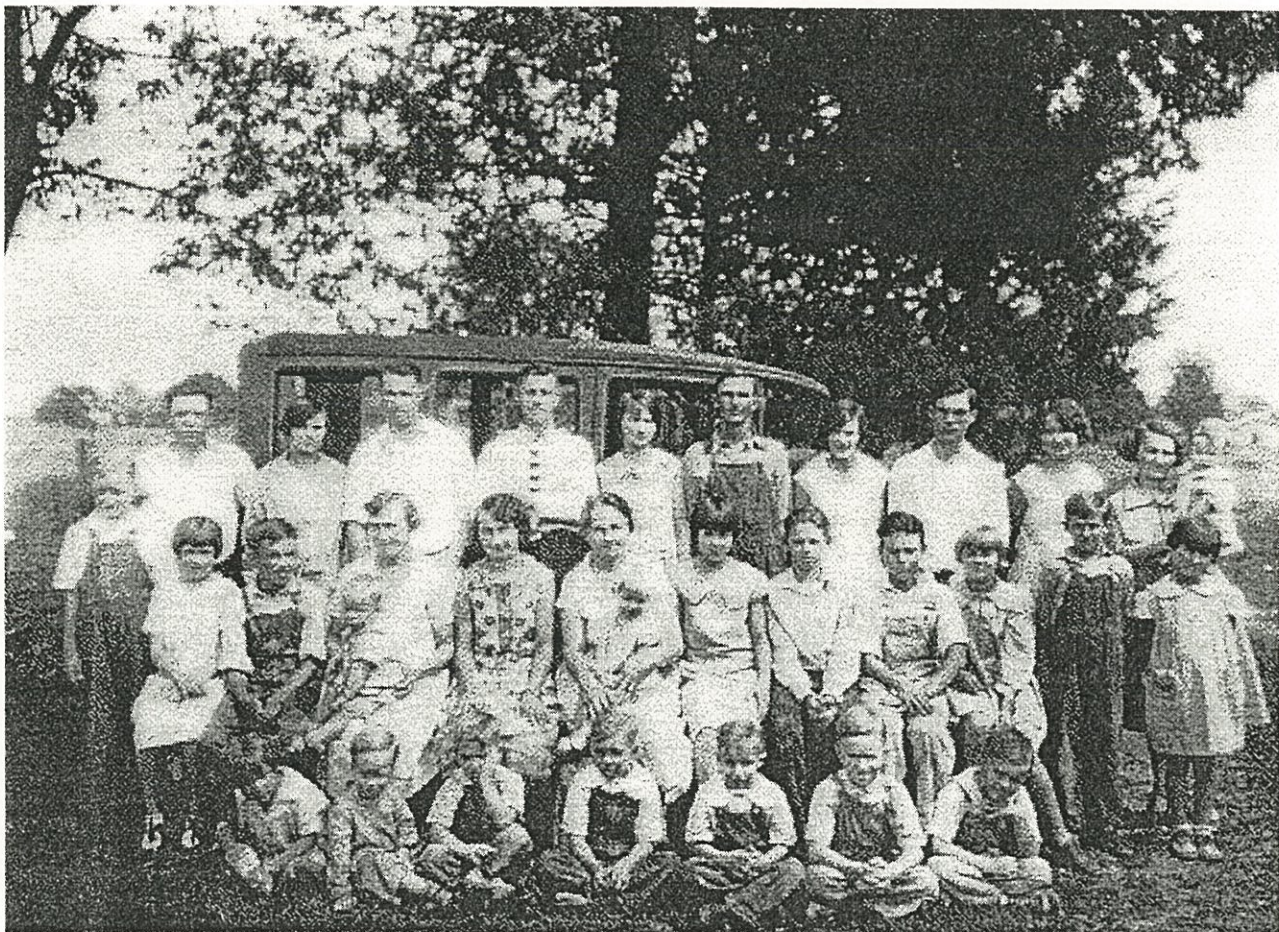

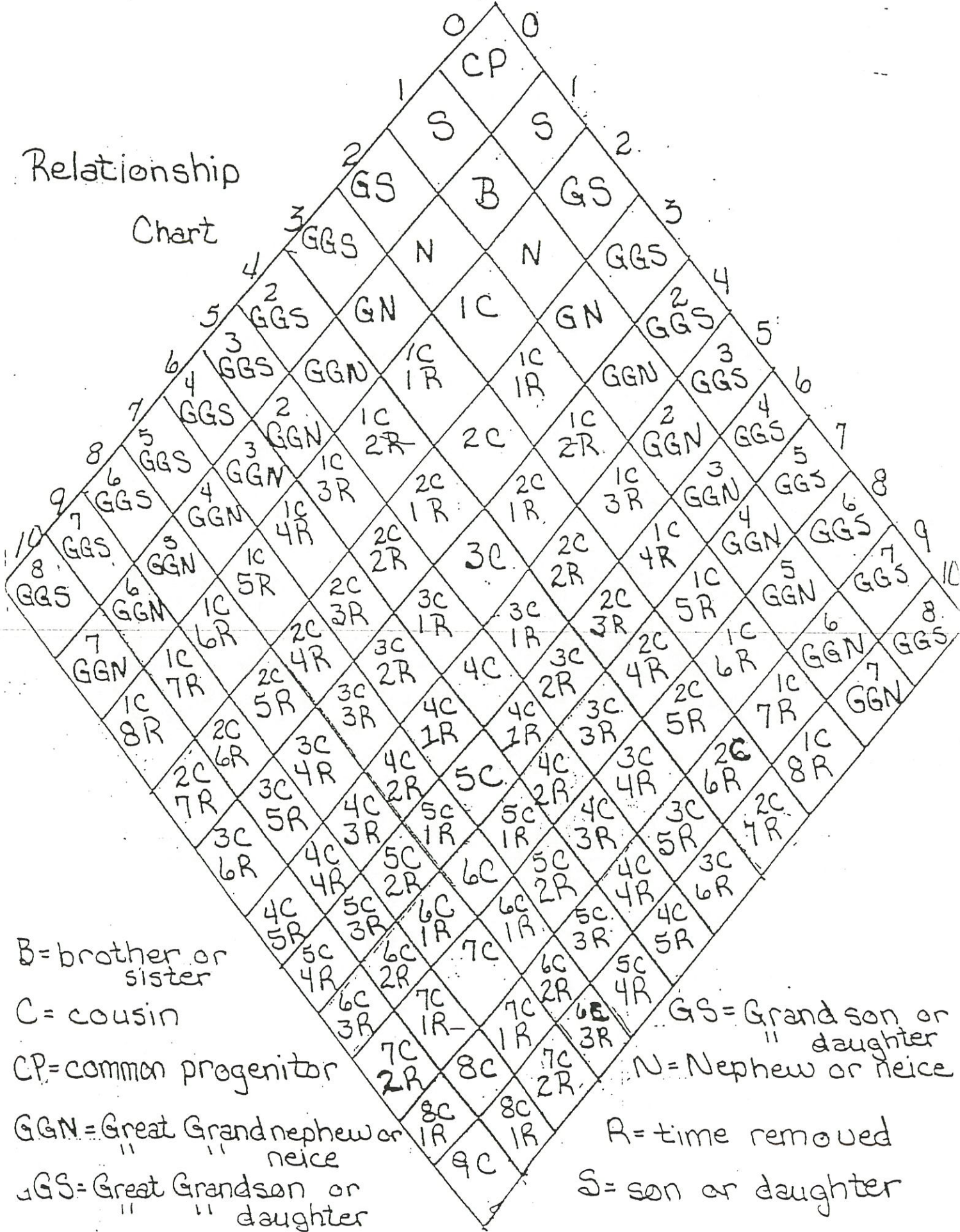
