

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Our training program is 100% Spiritual Proficiency as well as 100% Academic Excellence. This means that your spiritual development is as important as your academic achievements.

2. Each participant will be awarded an Advanced Diploma in either Strategic Leadership or Missions Ministry based on their choice of pursuit. Both programs are approximately 1 Year in span and participants regardless of their Major are expected to take and complete all subjects currently offered by the Institute. To graduate in any of the two programs, participants will be tested and graded on twelve subjects that include their Core Subjects. Participants must pass twelve subjects that include their Core to qualify for graduation.

3. Attendance at all scheduled programs is a must for all protégés. You must call in to inform of your absence from a program. Absence from a program is not an excuse for not participating in the assignments or exercises that took place in your absence. It is your responsibility to make arrangements to catch up with assignments, tests and exercises that took place in your absence. Please sign attendance records whenever you report for programs.

4. Assignments for your core courses must be taken seriously and submitted on time on or before the cutoff date. Assignments constitute a significant percentage of your overall grade for a course. The percentage component for the assignments for each course will be determined by the lecturer.

5. Tests for core courses of any major choice are compulsory and any failed tests will be retaken until success is achieved.

6. Prayer is a crucial and an integral part of the training. Everyone is expected to develop a consistent prayer life of at least 3 hours a day.

7. Fasting is also required for spiritual development. Full or partial abstinence at least twice a week on Tuesdays and Thursdays is required. Those with unique medical conditions should notify the institute.

8. Tithing is a covenant requirement for Christians to enjoy prosperity. You are expected to honor the covenant of tithing at your local Church

9. Studying the Bible, Books and Literature that relates to your calling is important for your proficiency.

10. You must know and obey the Ten Commandments:

- a. You shall have no other gods before Me
- b. You shall not make for yourself a graven image

c. You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain d. Remember the Sabbath Day, to keep it holy

e. Honor your father and mother – This includes your leaders in the institute, at work and in the community as a whole
