

**October 5, 2015**  
**Godwin Choral Boosters Meeting Minutes**

Lisa Bingen called the meeting to order at 7:05pm.

The minutes from the September 15, 2015 meeting were presented for review. A motion was made, and the minutes were approved by voice vote.

Reports from the Executive Board:

- 1<sup>st</sup> V.P of Membership: Alice reported that to date she has collected \$5040.00 in choral booster membership. The budget is set for \$5500.00 with a true goal being a little more than that. So far 39% of choral families have joined the boosters. Alice would like to have at least 50% join.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> V.P. of Ways & Means: Laurie Welch will be the chairperson for the winter raffle.
- Treasurer: Judi reported we have a budget of \$18,400. To date there has been \$2846.87 in expenses.
  - Audit: there was a \$55.70 discrepancy that ended up being an outstanding check that was written and never cashed. The check was voided but not entered properly in the records. Another error was a check for \$92.20 that was entered as \$92.90. Judi was able to find these errors and with an extension from the county will submit the audit this week. The audit next year should go smoothly.

Reports from the General Board Committee Chairs:

- Programs: Maritza needs advertisements, the choir lists, and music for the October concert program.
- Hospitality: Lorie reported that she is getting our hospitality inventory together. The first hospitality needs will be for the winter concert in December.
- Historian: Photos from the football game and concert will be collected.

Reports from General Fundraising Committee Chairs:

- Program Ads: Patrice reported that program ad sales are at \$1475.00. Patrice will still sell shout outs for the winter and spring concerts even though the budget for program ads has been met. After comparing prices to other printing companies we have discovered that our current printer is a good rate and good quality. Patrice plans on following up with the law firm that usually has a large ad in the program.
- Corporate Sponsor/Restaurants: Lisa reported that January 12<sup>th</sup> was not an available Spirit Night with Chipotle so a date in April has been booked. We are looking into booking a night at Glory Days.

- On a side note, Cathy Whitty made a request that chorus and drama help each other out by advertising for one another. We could make an announcement about the upcoming play at our spring concert. There are several choral students who are also involved in the drama productions.
- Premier Athletics: We are waiting on a proof at this time.

Choral Director's Report: Mr. Clatterbuck

- Bella Rosa is closing and they recommended we get our tuxedos from Tuxedo Warehouse in Midlothian. We will not be able to get the tuxedos from Bella Rosa as planned.
- Madrigals performed well at the investment assembly.
- Senior Honors Choir auditions are this Saturday. Those auditioning and the drivers are to meet at Godwin at 8:30am.
- Madrigals will perform the National Anthem at the Oct. 16<sup>th</sup> football game.
- Spring Concert in Oct. 18<sup>th</sup>. The boys should arrive at 2:00pm and the girls at 2:30pm. They should wear the black/white outfits.
- We are about finished with the dress orders.
- Debut will rehearse after school on Thursday next week. Mr. Clatterbuck is pleased with the new band for Debut. Debut is excited about the choreographer who will be working with them again on Oct. 24<sup>th</sup>.
- Acappella will perform at the Oct. 22<sup>nd</sup> volleyball game.
- Mr. Clatterbuck is very happy overall with the way the year has started.
