

## 2020 Marquette County Fairest of the Fair Program Obligations

1. Contestant must meet all eligibility requirements.
2. Personal interviews with the judges will be held on March 26th, 2020, with the other judged events and coronation to following. You will be contacted with interview time slots closer to competition. Contestant must be in attendance.
3. The winner will be required to attend the 2020 fair and attend the 2021 coronation. All contestants are strongly encouraged to attend Dairylicious Days, along with other community events, to help promote themselves as contestants and the fair. Specific duties may be assigned to the winner at events he or she attends.
4. The winner is encouraged to represent The Marquette County Fair at surrounding community festivals. Details about this portion will be given out to the contestant after his/her application is received by the program director.
5. Should the winner not be able to fulfill his/her obligations, the first runner-up will assume the duties of the Marquette County Fairest of the Fair.
6. The winner is required to assist during events at the Marquette County Fair or any events that they are not involved in. The 2020 Marquette County Fair will be held on July 9th through July 12th, 2020 .
7. The contestant must present themselves in an appropriate manner at all times when representing the fair. This includes appropriate business casual dress (no ripped jeans, short shorts, low cut tops, etc), no smoking, alcohol, tobacco or drug use, and limited cell phone use.
8. It is strongly encouraged for the 2020 Fairest to attend the 2021 State Fairest of the Fairs Convention in January to represent Marquette County at the state level.
