How To Reserve Your Seats

- ✓ The process has changed this year and everyone will book directly with Captain Bob. You pay Bob at the time of booking, either by credit card, Paypal or you can arrange to meet him at the dock in advance and pay by cheque or cash.
- **✓** The phone number is 727-807-6955
- ✓ I you decide to cancel your reservation you must call <u>72 hours</u> in advance of your booked trip and you will receive a refund minus a 3% merchant fee unless paid by cash or check.
- ✓ If Bob cancels the trip due to inclement weather or an insufficient number of participants, you will receive a 100% refund.
- ✓ Bob will hold 32 spots for GHC residents up to 72 hours in advance and after that will fill any remaining vacancies with outside people on his waiting list.
- ✓ If the dates we have booked for GHC do not suit your schedule you can ask Bob about different sailing dates he has open.
- ✓ This change should make it better for everyone including Capt. Bob. In the past there were a significant number of "No-Shows", partially filled seats or canceled cruises due to a low numbers of bookings certain days, making it difficult for him financially.
- Captain Bob also runs fishing tours if you would like to book a trip, just give him a call. His prices for GHC residents for up to 6 people, including tackle bait and licenses are

 - Inshore full day \$500
 - Offshore \$800

Thank you for completing the various forms mailed to you this season. Although we did not require an election, we were able to update our GHC records.

If you have not dropped off your signed Voter Certificate form, you may still do so.

Spectrum will "turn down analogue" TV services on July 1, 2018. You will require a TV Box to watch your TV after that date. You can still arrange for your one free TV Box.

MAINTENANCE CORNER

- **THE CARDBOARD RECYCLE BIN is much better. People are cooperating to break down boxes before putting them in the bin.
- **TOWER GARBAGE BINS are getting better. Please ALWAYS BAG garbage before putting in the bins.
- **CONTRACTORS: when you have contractors working at your unit, all garbage must be hauled away by the contractor you hired. OUR Garbage Bins are for owners only and not to be used by contractors to dispose of materials.
- **DRAIN ISSUES are getting better. IF you need to clear your sink drains, use NON-SUDSING Ammonia: Pour ½ cup down the drain and leave it overnight. In the morning, run lots of water down the drain. These will breakdown the grease yet it **won't hurt** our pipes like Drano does.
- **WATER: IF you have a leak or see water on your floor, PLEASE call the office ASAP. A small water issue can turn into a big water issue and may affect your neighbors.

CAM'S CORNER

For those of you that are interest in the new windows and since they are getting costly, the office is keeping a list of those interested and I am being told that if they can get at least 10 at one time they can give discounts. So, call the office and put your name on the list and we will let you know when we have enough and we will give those names to the different contractors and have them get back to you.
