Students will have the opportunity to play popular band tunes and gain valuable experience which will include individual, small group, and full band settings. An informal "Show and Tell" concert for family and friends will round out the week at 11 a.m. Cost \$40. Instructor: Josh Williams.

June 11-15: Beauty School Camp

8:30 to 11:30 a.m. at North Baldwin Center for Technology. (Rising 5th through 8th grades.) Through the week students will learn the ins and outs of several beauty techniques including shampoo and conditioning, braiding, manicures, pedicures, facials and make-up application. On Friday, students can invite a friend or relative to be on pampered with all the skills learned during the camp. Each day will also include a safety lesson for each technique presented. Students must provide their own make-up. Class size limited to 12 students.

June 11-12: "Sunken Treasure BREAKOUT Camp"

If so, join this mission to locate a mysterious sunken treasure. Team members will use clues and solve challenges to crack the codes of a variety of locks on Breakout Edu Boxes. June 18-21: "STEAM" Camp

8 to 11:30 a.m. at Bay Minette Middle School (rising 4th to 7th grades). Morning camp session (9 to 11 a.m.) is open to brass instrument players (trumpets, trombones, baritones).

1 to 3 p.m. at North Baldwin Infirmary Fitness Center. (Ages 7 to 11-years). This camp will educate children on the benefits of regular physical activity and proper nutrition. Topics include: Move and Groove as You Eat to Win; Heart-Smart Kids on the Liquid Lookout; Walk this Way/Snack Attack; Pump it Up/how Much to Eat; Toughen Up/Cut the Fat; Chill Out/Breakfast Don't Skip It; and Putting It All Together. The program is based on recommendations from the American Council on Exercise. Campers must provide completed physician referral form prior to the start of camp. The form will be mailed to all those who register. Cost: \$25. Instructors: Fitness Center Personal Trainers/Aerobics Instructors.

8:30 to 11:00 a.m. at Bay Minette Intermediate School. (Rising first through sixth grades). Students will have fun learning about Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM). We will explore science watching chemical reactions occur, experience technology by playing coding games, practice engineering with building challenges, and discover how math can make fun art!
