The Valcour Race is one of the optional races for the LCCS for the LCCS Champlain Series.

This race is named after Valcour Island and the area south of Plattsburgh known as Valcour, where many of the founding members of VSC lived and where the Club originally raced.

It was initially held in early June as two oneday races on the same weekend with an afternoon-evening party at Dr. David McDowell's Day Point home between races.

The course shall be designated on the VSC website and in a handout at the Skippers Meeting at the crane located near the Plattsburgh Boat Basin gas dock prior to the race. The starting area will be in Cumberland Bay. With an increase in B Boats, the Valcour Sailing Club may have two separate courses, one for A Boats and one for B Boats.

This race is the day after the Plattsburgh Mayors Cup, VSC's designated race in the Cannon/Goose Series of the Lake Champlain Championship Series.
