

MARION TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS MEETING July 14, 2015 Township Building

Present: Archie Gettig, Herb Chapman, John R. Dillon (Rick), and Angel Emery

Guests: Jerry McCloskey and Tim Weight

Chairman Gettig, called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chapman made a motion to approve the June 9th meeting minutes as presented, Gettig seconded, and Dillon abstained due to not being present at the June meeting. Motion passed 2-0

Public Comments: Jerry McCloskey mentioned that the Hazardous Mitigation Plan will be completed for review and approval in September. McCloskey will provide more information when it is available.

New Business:

Nittany Valley Joint Planning Commission- Gettig will not be in town for the July 16th meeting, Dillon, Chapman, and possibly Matt Wensel will attend. There will possibly be discussion of the I80 ramps at the meeting, Chapman asked Emery to try and get an accident count at the I80 ramps for the past two years.

Planning Commission- Triangle Trucking and Excavating plans were discussed. Recommendations from Engineer, Don Franson, were reviewed and discussed. **On a motion by Gettig and second by Dillon, motion passed to conditionally approve, as recommended by Franson and Marion Township Planning Commission, the Triangle Trucking plans as presented 3-0**

Park & Rec- No Meeting. Nothing to Report.

Head Road master Report- Gettig discussed report and presented price quotes for cut quick saws. **On a motion by Dillon and second by Gettig, motion passed to purchase TS 500-I 14" cut quick saw from Port's for \$965.00 3-0.**

Zoning Report- Weight discussed report with the supervisors.

Newsletter- Discussion was held about the newsletter that will soon be going out for Marion Township. The Supervisors suggested putting a spot in the newsletter suggesting residents that wish to have their septic tanks inspected in lieu of pumping have it done sooner instead of everyone waiting until the last minute and expecting Stan Wallace to get them all done.

Ordinance 2005-56- Discussion was held about ordinance 2005-56 which is the on lot septic pumping ordinance. **On a motion by Gettig and second by Chapman, motion passed to amend ordinance 2005-56 to six years between cycles as opposed to three years 3-0.**

Other Discussion Items:

Discussion was held about the alternate SEO helping Wallace out to get inspections done in a timelier manner. Emery was instructed to write a letter to Mr. Wallace suggesting the help of Jeffery Kreger, Marion Townships alternate SEO, during busy times.

On a motion by Chapman and second by Dillon motion passed to renew secretary bond with DeArment Insurance when renewal comes due 3-0.

Gettig made a motion to post pictures of post pounder and paint sprayer on township building door and accept sealed bids to be opened at 7:30 p.m. at next BOS meeting, Chapman seconded and motion passed 3-0.

Discussion was held about a belt conveyor that Bradco Supply Company has for sale. **On a motion by Chapman and second by Gettig, motion passed to purchase the belt from Bradco Supply 3-0.**

Chapman made a motion to accept Treasurer's Report and pay bills as presented, Gettig seconded, motion passed 3-0.

On a motion by Dillon and second by Chapman, motion passed to adjourn meeting at 8:34 p.m. 3-0.
