President's Message

I want to review a couple things that many of you noticed when posting your back 9 score in the July tournament. Some of you couldn't find an option to post a 9-hole tournament round, because there isn't one! Like the rules said, post it as HOME. After you post, you don't see the 9-hole round in your list of recent scores. To see your 9-hole rounds, you need to change the option form recent rounds to "Nine Hole/Combined". When you post a 9-hole score, the GHIN system holds it until you post another 9-hole score. Then it combines them for an 18-hole score, based on the ratings and slopes of the two nines that you played. This is why you need to be sure to select the correct front/back nine and blue/white tees, as they all have different ratings and slopes. After two scores are combined in to an 18-hole score, it shows up in your recent rounds with a "C" after the score.

If you play Saturday Skins, I'm sure you've noticed that we've been changing the way we do the closest to the pin pots. The low handicappers really need to play the 3-pars from the real blue yardages to keep their handicap realistic, but we can't have blue and white tees competing for the same pot. At the same time, we don't want the payouts too small if we have separate pots. We tried giving each flight one 3-par, plus one combined pot, and had mixed feedback. Our other idea was to raise the buy in and have separate pots. A survey of Saturday players favored this idea, so we're raising the buy in to \$20. It's been \$15 for as long as we can remember, so we're probably due for an increase anyway. Please let us know how you like the new payouts.

We are starting to see more talk about the new rules coming in 2019, including segments from the R&A during the Open tournament TV broadcasts. I remind you that the only new rule in effect right now is a local rule for no penalty for accidentally moving the ball or marker on the green. A big education campaign is starting this fall, with messaging coming from the USGA, the SCGA, and of course your local El Prado Men's Club. Please pay attention to the messages, and watch the videos, so that we can be ready when the new rules take effect in January. The more we know, the fewer issues we can expect during competition.
