This \$500 scholarship is given by the Columbus-Fall River Sno-Blazers Snowmobile Club to continue their legacy.

Scholarship Requirements:

- You must be a **current member** of the Columbus-Fall River Sno-Blazers Snowmobile Club, an active member of the National FFA Organization for at least two consecutive years **OR** the child of a current landowner where the Sno-Blazers trails pass through. (One of the three qualifies for eligibility).
- You must be a senior attending any high school in the surrounding area **OR** enrolled at a university/technical college and under the age of 21 years old as of December 31, 2022.

The following requirements need to all be in one PDF, to ensure we receive everything and have the ability to open it.

- Application **MUST** be typed.
- A letter of recommendation from a current snowmobile club member, FFA member, mentor or teacher, (no parents or family members) with your application.

To ensure we receive completed applications by the deadline, it is suggested that you have your reference type their letter and email it to you. Please include this in the one PDF with the application and your essay. Applications not submitted properly will not be considered.

The \$500 scholarship award will be issued after you finish the first semester of college and you provide documentation for the completion of the first semester and enrollment in the second semester.

If you are eligible, you may apply for the scholarship as it is offered, but may only be awarded as the recipient one-time, regardless of continued eligibility.
