

The Cottages

The heart of a person's home is the kitchen and living room. Our Cottages replicate this with an open kitchen and dining room floor plan completed with a large harvest table where everyone gathers for meals. Our spacious living room is accented with a large stone fireplace that offers a cozy environment for our residents to lounge, visit or watch television. Our Cottages honor a growing desire for private accommodations. Each of the twelve rooms have their own private bedrooms and full bathrooms. Our Cottages staff a team of universal workers called P.A.L.s and licensed nurses that provide 24 hours a day care for our residents. This team strives to provide excellent care as well as bonds with the residents and their families. This team is aided by a clinical support team including social workers, therapists, physicians, activity and dietary professionals and pharmacists.

Skilled Nursing

Quality care and a team approach are important to our skilled nursing program. Individual care plans are created through the input of staff, residents and the family. Skilled nursing care is provided to the resident as ordered by the physician. Hospice, respite care and short term stays are also available. A team of licensed therapists, as well as restorative therapy specialists, work at maximizing the potential of each resident through physical, speech, and occupational therapy.

Residential Care

Secure and cozy apartments are available for residents needing a little extra help with activities of daily living. Supportive services that many seniors need to maintain the delicate balance between independence and assistance are available on a daily basis. The staff members are attentive to needs of seniors. Meals served family style in the dining room; weekly housekeeping and laundry services; supervision of medications and health related problems; skilled therapies and beauty shop services are only a few of the amenities of our Residential Care Apartments.

Alzheimer's Neighborhood

Safety is a top priority at Loch Haven's Special Brook, we pride ourselves in providing quality care in a way that allows our Alzheimer/dementia residents to have a sense of security, well being and self worth. Our secured neighborhood has a home like feel with areas for dining, activities and relaxation. A deck with a water feature and patio furniture offers a serene, comfortable space for our residents to enjoy outside activities or just sit and relax. A full calendar of activities is offered daily.
