The dance studio will be closed for our annual winter break December 21 - January 2. (Note the date changes!)

We hope that everyone has a wonderful holiday season!

RECITAL COSTUMES

We will begin taking measurements for recital costumes this week. It's important that we get all dancers' measurements before we go on Winter Break December 21. Any measurements taken after December 21 will be placed in a later order and will arrive at a later date than our main order.

We allow extra growth room when we order your child's costume. We place the order early so that if there are any fitting problems there is still time to return them before the recital. Costumes are not custom made to a dancer's specific measurements. Some minor alterations may be required

Please note that the costume total will include recital tights, but it will not include costume alterations. Parents will be responsible for any alterations to their child's costume.

Please note also that there was a \$35 costume deposit due in October for each costume we order for your dancer. Deposits still unpaid are currently accruing interest charges.

Costume balances will be included in the autopay cycle that runs on January 5. Costumes will not be distributed to dancers until the costume fee is paid and all tuition payments are up to date.

Costume prices will be recorded in your dancer's account by the end of December. Please log in to your account to see the balance.

If you have misplaced your login information you can always go the MVDC website, www.miamivalleydancecenter.com, and click on the Student Login tab. On the next page click the Student Account Login link, then on the next page there will be yet another link to help if you have forgotten your login and/or password.

By the way, we'll post a photo of your child's costume in your dancer's on-line account for your viewing.

Remember, the studio might still be open even if local schools are closed, and vice versa.






CONVENTION NEWS

The five dancers shown in the photo above (left to right) Leah Snow, Amelia Doyle, Dain Lourens,


