Block Challenge

The Block Challenge is a fun entry offered at every quilt show. You'll want to be a part of this. The way it works is as follows:

*You must purchase our western theme fat quarters which will be sold at the guild meeting starting at our February meeting. Price will be \$3.00. You may purchase more than one fat quarter.

- *Additional fabrics may be used; however, the western fabric must be used.
- *All work must be completed by the submitter.
- *Blocks may be hand or machine stitched.
- *Blocks may be original designs or traditional patterns.
- *Blocks may be 6 1/2 , 9 $\frac{1}{2}$, or 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ UNFINISHED.
- *All blocks will be measured when turned in. Inaccurate blocks will be returned.
- *Points must have $\frac{1}{4}$ inch seam allowance. Points may not be cut off.
- * Entry forms are available from Kathy Thompson and must be submitted with completed blocks. Please put your block in a zip lock bag.

Blocks submitted to this contest will become the property of Baytown Area Quilt Guild for use in a future quilt for fundraising.

Cash prizes will be awarded as follows: 1st place \$30, 2nd place \$25, 3rd place \$20. Each person attending the show will be given one ticket to vote for their favorite block in the challenge..
