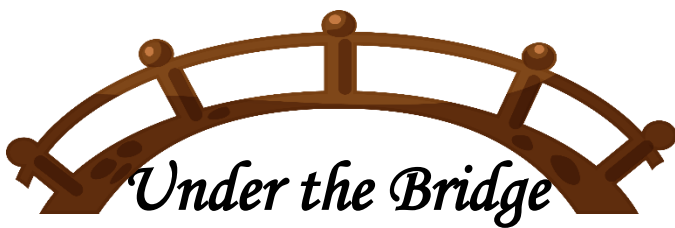
Thank you to everyone who came to help get the Missile Mayhem site ready for the upcoming event. The camping area looks great and there are already ideas for next year.
