There were 48 members at the end of 2018, 7 members did not renew for 2019 and 3 new members joined the club for 2019. At of the end of 2019 we have 47 active members and 2 life members.

Test Secretary Report

Prepared and presented by Eileen Fisher. A motion made by Stephanie McMahon and seconded by Susan Rickwood to accept the Test Secretary report was passed unanimously.

CCTC held the following 5 tracking tests in 2019:

Urban Test held on April 14, 2019. Judge Marie-P Babin.

There were 3 entries in the UTD Test and there was 1 pass.

There were 3 entries in the UTDX Test and unfortunately there were no passes.

TD/TDX Test held on May 12, 2019. The Judge was Marie-P Babin.

There were 2 entries in the TD Test, and both passed.

There were 3 entries in the TDX Test and there was 1 pass.

TD/TDX Test held on September 29, 2019. Judge was Marie-P Babin.

Marie replaced the original judge, Mary Anne Boulet, at the last minute, due to injury.

There were 2 entries in the TD Test and 1 in the UTDX Test.

Unfortunately, there were no passes in either test.

Urban Test held on October 20, 2019. Judge Marie-P Babin.

There were 3 entries in the UTD Test. 1 withdrew and the other 2 both passed.

There were 3 entries in the UTDX Test and unfortunately there were no passes.

TD/TDX Test held on November 03, 2019. Judge Sandy Briggs.

There were 4 TD entries and 1 pass.

There were 3 TDX entries and 1 pass.

In summary: There was a total of 6 dogs entered in UTD and 3 passes (50% pass rate)

There was a total of 6 dogs entered in UTDX and on passes (0% pass rate)

There was a total of 8 dogs entered in TD and 3 passes (38% pass rate)

There was a total of 6 dogs entered in TDX and 2 passes (33% pass rate)

Thank you again for all the track layers who came out for the weekends of the tests and for the Test Secretaries who work hard to keep the paperwork up to date.

A special thanks to our tireless President, who ended up judging 4 of the 5 Tests this year.

Hopefully 2020 will give her more time to work her own dog.

Because of the uncertainty regarding the availability of our usual fields, we have decided to only run 4 Tests in 2020, leaving out the September TD/TDX Test. They will be as follows:

April 26, 2020: an Urban Test. Judge Marie-P Babin. We really can't hold her down LOL

May 10, 2020: a TD/TDX Test. Judge Laura McKay.

October 18, 2020: an Urban Test. Judge Marie-P Babin.

November 08, 2020: a TD/TDX Test. Judge Jack Wilhelm.

Hopefully we will have great tracking in 2020, both in fun get togethers for practice and in Test passes. Remember also that winter tracking can be fun, so get an early start on the year.

New Business


We are looking for new fields for the Spring to hold our tests. Marie will check with Sue Betts about the fields belonging to her neighbour.


There being no other new business, a motion was made by Anne Passafiume, seconded by Lynda Rupay to adjourn the meeting was passed unanimously.
