SUMMARY OF WORK TASKS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- A. Follow all YCKC Procedures and Policies and Health and Safety guideline;
- B. Take the appropriate National certification for basic coaching skills in the sport;
- C. Assist the Head Coach in:
 - 1. Administrative duties and computer tasks;
 - Planning, development and execution of summer on-water and on-land programs;
 - 3. Coaching athletes;
 - 4. Designing and executing team-building activities;
 - 5. Planning and developing the Yorkton Developmental Regatta;
 - 6. Communicating to parents/caregivers of youth participants;
 - 7. Equipment maintenance;
 - 8. Operating rescue boat correctly and safely (complete Boat Operating Licence);
 - 9. Basic First Aid treatment and water safety;
 - 10. Attend meetings with Head Coach on behalf of YCKC as required;
 - 11. Be an ambassador of YCKC and model YCKC's values in daily conduct.
- D. Sprint Canoe/Kayaking is a sport that allows people of various ranges of physical fitness and physiques to be active in a safe, welcoming, and accepting environment. The Assistant Coach must demonstrate a high level of compassion, understanding, patience, respect, and knowledge to be an effective coach.
