

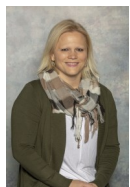
## Clinic Coaching Staff

### Head Coach

#### Gretta Melsted 13<sup>th</sup> Year



Coach Melsted has been the head softball coach at Augustana since July of 2006 and is coming off another successful season. Melsted owns a career record of 548-301, including 467-210 in 12 seasons at Augustana. Melsted surpassed two career milestones during the 2017 season, picking up her 500th career win and her 400th win at Augustana. Melsted has guided the Vikings to seven NCAA Tournament appearances, including six straight trips from 2010 to 2015. After missing the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2009 in 2016, Melsted returned to the tournament in 2017 and led her team to the Central Super Region 2 Tournament title game. The Vikings finished 40-16 in 2017 and 42-15 in 2018. She was named the 2009, 2010, & 2011 Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference Coach of the Year. In addition, the 2012 staff was named the NFCA Central Region Coaching staff of the year.



### Assistant Coach

#### Kelsey Thompson 1st Year

Kelsey Thompson rejoins the Augustana Softball Coaching Staff after previously serving as an assistant coach from 2010-2013. During her previous tenure at Augustana, the Vikings amassed a record of 135-56, appeared in 3 NCAA tournaments including 2 super regional appearances in 2011 & 2012. In 2012, the Vikings earned a trip to the NCAA Division II Women's College World Series.

After her time at Augustana, Thompson led the University of Sioux Falls for 5 straight 30+ win seasons from 2013-2018. In her time at USF, Thompson and her staff produced 37 All-NSIC Academic All-Conference performers, 15 All-NSIC performers, 1 NFCA All-Region performer & 1 NFCA All-American.



### Assistant Coach

#### Nat Wagner 3rd Year

Coach Nat Wagner joins the Augustana staff for his third season as the assistant coach for the Vikings. Wagner brings an extensive coaching background with him to Augustana after spending the 2015 and 2016 seasons as an assistant coach at Valley City State University. During Wagner's tenure as an assistant coach at Valley City State, the Vikings went 64-35 over two seasons, including a 40-13 record in 2016. Wagner served as the lead recruiting coordinator at Valley City State and corresponded with all incoming recruits and coordinated visits. Prior to joining the staff at VCSU, he Wagner spent two seasons as the head coach at New Prague High School in Minnesota. Wagner began his coaching career in 1997. He got his start in college softball at the University of St. Thomas where he helped the Tommies win a conference championship.

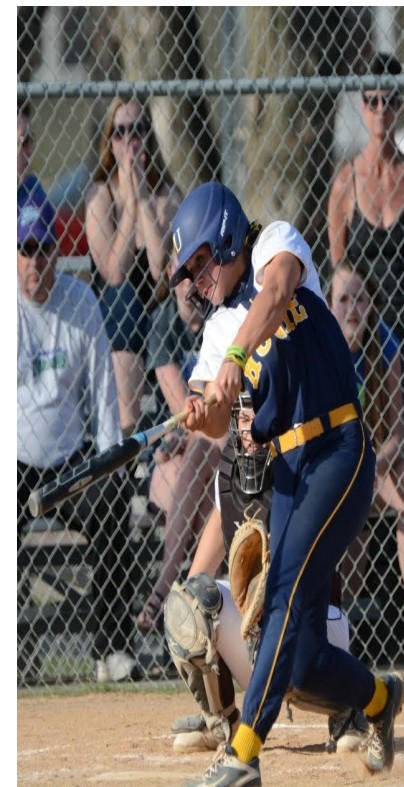

## Clinic News

-Registration for all clinics will take place in the half hour preceding that clinic session

-Those attending pitching clinics must bring their **own glove and catcher**

-Please bring your **own bat** for the hitting clinics and your own glove for any of the fielding clinics

-All hitting clinics will be at the Bill Hall Baseball/ Softball Complex located at the corner of 37th St. and Lake Avenue. Pitching, catching, and elite defense will be at the Elmen Center located at the corner of 33rd St. and Grange Avenue.



### #6 Advanced Pitching Clinic \$65

The clinic is limited to 18 athletes. The clinic will include advanced technique and form as well as instruction and critique in throwing the drop, rise, screw, drop curve, and change-up. The Augie Coaching Staff will analyze pitches with the help of advanced high speed video analysis.

Pitchers must provide their own catcher.

### #1/7 Pitching (Grades 3-6) Clinic \$45

Beginner clinics will include mechanics, practice drills, training instruction and continuous one-on-one feedback. Beginner clinics will also include basic technique and form instruction on throwing a change-up. Pitchers must provide their own catcher.

### #4 Pitching (Grades 7-12) Clinic \$45

Intermediate pitching clinic will include technique and form as well as instruction and critique on throwing the fastball, change-up, drop, and rise. Pitchers must provide their own catcher.

### #5/8 Catching Clinic \$45

Catching clinics will focus on all of the mechanics of catching including: posture, glove position, framing, fielding bunts, blocking balls, pop-ups, throwing to bases, receiving throws and retrieving wild pitches. Information on calling a game, relationship with the umpire, and helping the pitcher will also be covered. Catchers should bring gear.

### #2/10 Advanced Hitting Clinic \$65

The clinic is limited to 26 athletes. Each athlete will get one-on-one instruction, advanced hitting drills as well as swing analysis from the Augie Coaching Staff. This clinic will help participants learn to hit like the Augie players through advanced drills regularly performed in day-to-day practice routines.

### #3/9 Hitting Clinics (Grades 3-6) \$45

Hitting clinics will focus on mechanics, one-on-one instruction in the batting cage, tee drills, vision training drills, and demonstration by the Augie players. Instruction emphasizes good form, swing speed, weight transfer, positive-feedback and hitting progression used by the current Augustana hitters.
