

LELAND L (LEE) VANDEMARK

1954 - 1994

Leland L. (Lee) Vandemark, 39 of Unionville, accidentally drowned Sunday, Jan. 2, while ice fishing off Thomas Marina near Fish Point.

He was born Jan. 10, 1954, in Flint, the son of Eldon Lloyd and Gladys Irene (Gamer) Vandemark. He was a 1972 graduate of Unionville High School and served in the U.S. Army in Thailand during the Vietnam Conflict.

Mr. Vandemark married Elodie VanDePutte on April 27, 1984, in the Moravian Church Unionville. She survives him. He was employed as a marine mechanic at Don's Sport Shop in Sebawang since 1988. He was a member of the National Rifle Association.

Surviving besides his wife Elodie are one son, Eddie Vandemark and one daughter, Myra Vandemark, both at home; his parents, Eldon and Gladys Vandemark of Unionville; one sister, Debra Vandemark of Williamsburg, Va.,
