She was very appreciative of the \$800.00 because the HSDR does not receive any government funding, relying solely upon charitable donations from clubs, organizations, and individuals. The Humane Society is a charitable community resource dedicated to protecting and providing temporary shelter and comfort to all animals in need, reuniting lost pets with their owners, providing spaying/neutering services, micro chipping, and other veterinary services.

Blair was impressed by the generous contributions of pet food and supplies. She was looking forward to sharing John and Judy's custom made "doggy cake" with the lucky dogs at the shelter. Blair said the dog and cat food would be used at the shelter, as well as given to Pet Food Banks. People who need to access the Pet Food Banks are able to feed their pets so they aren't forced to surrender them to the Humane Society.









