MID-VALLEY SOFTBALL UMPIRE ASSOCIATION PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO MVSUA BY-LAWS

Overview:

This amendment was brought up to better help clarify the role of the commissioner in terms of being an umpire and self assigning.

The **CURRENT** MVSUA By-Law Read as follows:

Commissioner Section 5 Eligibility to Officiate

Eligibility to Officiate: The Commissioner is only to officiate on an emergency basis

The **PROPOSED** MVSUA By-Law **TO READ** as follows:

Commissioner Section 5 Eligibility to Officiate

The commissioner is to officiate on an emergency basis. If the commissioner needs to work that day they will prioritize working the lowest level of game on the schedule and in doing so the commissioner will move qualified officials up to fill assignments and take that official's spot in the schedule. The executive board will approve any assignments the commissioner is assigned to officiate.

Failure to comply will result in a monetary fine that will be the discretion of the executive board.
