



August 18, 2021 – COVID/Visitation Update

Good afternoon from Midway Nursing Home!

This is an important COVID-19 visitation update. Today is the last day of precautionary quarantine for the 3rd floor. Two rounds of outbreak testing were conducted for all residents and staff and there were no additional positive cases.

Visitation for fully vaccinated residents, is from 1:15 PM to 7 PM – Sunday through Friday – no appointment is necessary. Visits for unvaccinated or residents that are not fully vaccinated still require an appointment. Please contact Connie Leone on ext. 307 to schedule an appointment.

As a reminder, **visitors must always wear a facemask which covers the nose and mouth while on facility premises. Visitors who don't adhere to this or are unable to comply will not be allowed to visit.** There are **no exceptions** to the facemask requirement.

No food or beverages are permitted in the visitation area as this requires removal of facemasks. Use of hand sanitizer is required prior to & during the visit. Please maintain social distance from staff and other visitors at all times.

We ask that you be mindful to your loved one's routine/schedule and make your visit at a time that is best for your loved one. For example, if your loved one rests at certain time, avoid visiting at that time.

Virtual/Facetime visits are available daily. We highly encourage you to call Social Services or Recreation to schedule a Virtual/Facetime visit with your loved one.

COVID-19 is not gone. In fact, the COVID positivity rate continues to rise. If you have not yet been vaccinated or consented for your loved one here, please re-consider. We must use everything in our arsenal to put this virus behind us. The more people that are vaccinated, the less chance we give this virus to adapt into other more transmissible and deadly strains.

Please continue to wear a mask while outside your home, wash or sanitize your hands often and avoid places where you are not able to social distance. Stay well and safe.
