AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF MARBLE, COLORADO ADOPTING THE UNIFORM MECHANICAL CODE, 1979 EDITION, AS PROMULGATED BY THE INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE OF BUILDING OFFICIALS, 5360 SOUTH WORKMAN MILL ROAD, WHITTIER, CALIFORNIA, IN-CLUDING ALL APPENDICES, AND UNIFORM PLUMBING CODE STANDARDS FOR PURPOSES OF PROVIDING MINIMUM STANDARDS TO SAFEGUARD LIFE OR LIMB, HEALTH, PROPERTY AND PUBLIC WELFARE BY REGU-LATING AND CONTROLLING THE DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION, INSTALLATION, QUALITY OF MATERIALS, LOCATION, OPERATION, QUALITY OF MATERIALS, LOCATION,
OPERATION, AND MAINTENANCE OF HEATING, VENTILATING,
COOLING, REFRIGERATOR, INCINERATOR, AND OTHER MISCELLANEOUS HEAT PRODUCING APPLIANCES IN THE TOWN OF MARBLE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MARBLE, COLORADO, THAT

For purposes of providing minimum standards to safeguard SECTION 1. life or limb, health, property, and public welfare by regulating and controlling the design, construction, installation, quality of materials, location, operation, and maintenance of heating, ventilating, cooling, refrigerator, incinerator, and other miscellaneous heat producing appliances in the Town of Marble. The Uniform Mechanical Code, 1979 Edition as promulgated by the International Conference of Building Officials, 5360 South Workman Mill Road, Whittier, California 90601, is hereby adopted.

It is unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation SECTION 2. to violate the standards provided in the Uniform Mechanical Code, 1979 Edition, in the regulation and controlling of the design, construction, installation, quality of materials, location, operation, and maintenance of heating, ventilating, cooling, refrigerator, incinerator, and other miscellaneous heat producing appliances located in the Town of Marble.

Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of the Uniform Mechanical Code, 1979 Edition, SECTION 3. as adopted in this chapter is guilty of a misdemeanor, and such person is guilty of a separate offense for each and every day or portion thereof during which any violation of any of the provisions of the Uniform Mechanical Code, 1979 Edition, is committed, continued, or permitted, and upon conviction of any such violation, such person shall be punishable by a fine of not more than three hundred dollars or by imprisonment for not more than ninety days, or by both such fine and imprison-
