Hamburg Cemetery Rules and Regulations Set by Hocking Township Board of Trustees April 22, 2008 Revised October 25, 2016

- 1. SALE OF LOTS: No New lots shall be sold within this Cemetery.
- 2. BURIALS: Opening and closing of graves must be arranged through the funeral home. Payment is due prior to interment.
- 3. When a lot is sold or given to another owner, the Township Fiscal Officer shall be notified in writing so that a new deed can be prepared and recorded.
- 4. Burial vaults shall be used.
- 5. Government provided headstones or markers may be used as a footstone or to supplement a private monument or be affixed to an existing inscribed monument.
- 6. Artificial flowers or wreaths are not permitted April 1st to October 1st.
- 7. Grave blankets must be removed by March 15th, each year.
- 8. Planting of trees or shrubs is not permitted and will be removed at the discretion of the Board of Trustees.
- 9. Planting of annual or perennial flowers is permitted. Please plant flowers next to marker stones. Plants are to be maintained by the family and subject to removal by the Board of Trustees. Potted plants or cut flowers placed on graves are subject to removal by the Board of Trustees when or if they become unsightly.
- 10. No single markers over 18" X 30"
- 11. No markers over 70% of grave width by 20" on larger graves.
- 12. Monument Companies need to contact the Hocking Township Board of Trustees prior to digging to set a monument.
- 13. The township is not responsible for maintaining memorials put up by individuals in the past and anything out of the ordinary must be checked out with the Board of Trustees prior to placing in the cemetery.
