People: Give me understanding, that I may observe Your law and keep it with all my heart.

Liturgist- Make me walk in the path of Your commandments, for I delight in it.

People: Incline my heart to Your testimonies and not to dishonest gain.

Matthew 18: 15-20 **Second Reading**

Liturgist: If another believer sins against you, go privately and point out the offense.

People: If the other person listens and confesses it, you have won that person back.

Liturgist: But if you are unsuccessful, take one or two others with you and go back again, so that everything you say may be confirmed by two or three witnesses.

People: If the person still refuses to listen, take your case to the church. Then if he or she will not accept the church's decision, treat that person as a pagan or a corrupt tax collector.

Liturgist: I tell you the truth, whatever you forbid on earth will be forbidden in heaven, and whatever you permit on earth will be permitted in heaven.

People: I also tell you this: If two of you agree here on earth concerning anything you ask, my Father in heaven will do it for you.

ALL: For where two or three gather together as my followers, I am there among them." **Third Reading** Romans 13: 8-14

Owe nothing to anyone—except for your obligation to love one another. If you love your neighbor, you will fulfill the requirements of God's law. For the commandments say, "You must not commit adultery. You must not murder. You must not steal. You must not covet." These—and other such commandments—are summed up in this one commandment: "Love your neighbor as yourself." Love does no wrong to others, so love fulfills the requirements of God's law. This is all the more urgent, for you know how late it is; time is running out. Wake up, for our salvation is nearer now than when we first believed. The night is almost gone; the day of salvation will soon be here. So, remove your dark deeds like dirty clothes, and put on the shining armor of right living. Because we belong to the day; we must live decent lives for all to see. Do not participate in the darkness of wild parties and drunkenness, or in sexual promiscuity and immoral living, or in quarreling and jealousy. Instead, clothe yourself with the presence of the Lord Jesus Christ. And do not let yourself think about ways to indulge your evil desires.

In the words of the Apostle Paul as recorded in 1 Corinthians 11: 23-26, I pass on to you what I received from the Lord himself. On the night when he was betrayed, the Lord Jesus took some bread and gave thanks to God for it. Then he broke it in pieces and said, "This is my body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me." In the same way, he took the cup of wine after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant between God and his people—an agreement confirmed with my blood. Do this in remembrance of me as often as you drink it." Every time you eat this bread and drink this cup, you are announcing the Lord's death until he comes again.

The People: Christ has died. Christ is risen. Christ will come again.

RECEIVING THE ELEMENTS

This is the body of Christ that was broken for you. (eat the bread)

This is the blood of Christ, shed for you. (drink the wine)
