ORDINANCE NO. 5

UNLAWFUL TO INJURE SHADE TREES, EXCEPTIONS, PENALTIES. — No person shall girdle, cut down, destroy or willfully injure any shade trees, standing or planted on or along any of the streets of Rolla, and any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall be punished by a fine of not less than Five dollars nor more than One Hundred dollars and costs of prosecution; provided however that this section shall not affect the right of the owner of any lot or parcel of lands in the city from removing or cutting trees, standing on the sides of any streets, adjoining his respective lot or parcel of land, nor the right of the city officers to remove any trees, which the City Council may order to be removed or cut down.
