Club Business for the Christmas Party

WE had to cancel two shows for weather this year. It became clear that we did not have a clear, written cancelation/refund policy for such events. We looked around to see what other clubs were doing and this is what we came up with.

PDNDS Schooling Show Cancellation Policy

No Refunds after closing date or for weather or safety issues that require management to cancel classes or days of competition. If the show is cancelled due to weather or safety issues, management will automatically apply the class entry fee towards a subsequent PDNDS schooling show in the same calendar year. Otherwise, upon written request by the competitor to the show secretry, class entry fees will be refunded. To accommodate for work done by the show secretary, facility and judge, Office and facility fees are not refundable or usable for future shows.

When the club cancels a show we still have expenses for the facility and the judge, not to mention all the office supplies. This will help cover the costs of doing business.

We will be voting on this at the Christmas Party.

YEAR-END AWARD RULES

1. General.

- Year-end awards are earned between January 1st and December 1st and are presented at the first regular membership meeting of the year.
- A champion and a reserve champion are recognized at each level; champions receive a \$50.00 award and all others receive certificates.
- All competitive scores earned must be judged under current USEF dressage rules, except as modified by PdNDS, and be from PdNDS sponsored shows.
- •Ties will be awarded equally.

•Junior/young riders are considered a separate division where applicable. • For purposes of competition in all PDNDS sponsored shows: USEF rule DR119.3 is applicable. Individuals are eligible as Juniors until the end of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 18. Individuals are eligible as Young Riders from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 16 until the end of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 21 •. Competitors shall compete as adults (PdNDS Open) from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 22. 2. Eligibility. •To be eligible, both the rider and the horse owner must be dues-paying members of PdNDS in good standing. •Memberships must have been in effect at the time the scores were earned. •Horse and rider combinations are only eligible to win awards twice at the same level. 3. Awards. a. Intro-Second Level. •The average of a minimum number of scores to be determined at the end of the show season based on the number of shows held. Scores from at least three judges will be considered. JR/YR and Open divisions. b. Third and Fourth Levels. • The average of a minimum number of scores to be determined at the end of the show season based on the number of shows held. Scores from at least three judges will be considered. JR/YR and Open divisions. c. FEI Levels. •The average of a minimum of the best three scores from at least two judges will be considered. JR/YR

and Open divisions.

- d. Freestyle Award:
- Awarded to the horse and rider combination with the highest average freestyle score. This award consists of botha\$50.00 award and a certificate. JR/YR and Open divisions
- e. Western Dressage Award
- Awarded to the horse and rider combination with the highest average score in the Western Dressage classes. This award consists of both a\$50.00 award and a certificate. JR/YR and Open divisions
- f. Eventing Class Award.
- Awarded to the horse and rider combination with the highest average score in class # 19 Eventing TOC. This award consists of both a\$50.00 award and a certificate. JR/YR and Open divisions.
- g. NTD(New to Dressage) Award:
- Awarded to the horse and rider combination with the highest average score in New to Dressage classes at schooling shows and Opportunity classes at Amigos de Dressage. Winners of NTD must not have competed in Dressage shows before June 1 of the previous calendar year. ALL RIDERS ARE UNDER ONE DIVISION FOR THIS AWARD.

TRAVELING TROPHY AWARDS

- e. Titsworth Award:
- Awarded annually to the horse and adult rider combination with the single highest score adjusted for level. The award is a traveling trophy inscribed with the winner's name each year.
- f. Banjo Award:
- Awarded annually to the horse and junior/young rider combination with the single highest score adjusted for level. The award is a traveling trophy inscribed with the winner's name each year.

- g. Gladiator Award:
- Awarded to the highest average score of two first level tests at any schooling show.
- h. Cassidy Award:
- •Awarded annually to the thoroughbred horse and rider combination with the single highest score adjusted for level. The award is a traveling trophy inscribed with the winner's name each year
- .i. Gambler Award:
- Awarded annually to the rider with the single highest score posted by an adult amateur at or above second level. The award is a travelling trophy.

ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS

- 1. General.
- Achievement awards are an addition to year-end awards and are presented upon the accumulation of four scores at or above the required percentage from four different judges.
- 2. Eligibility.
- •The rider must be a dues paying member of PdNDS. A nominating fee is not required.
- 3. Scores.
- The four scores required for these awards must be from USEF or USDF licensed dressage judges ("L" judges or above). Scores are cumulative; there is no specified time during which scores must be earned. Members are responsible for submitting their scores to the awards coordinator; especially those scores earned outside PdNDS sponsored events, and must do so prior to the annual awards compilation
