Greetings dear co-sojourners for 2024 ... Our prayer and hope for all (including families) who partner with Tiyamike is for a wonderfull year ahead with more of the reality of Holy Spirit's presence in all our lives. He does love glorifying Jesus our Lord!! (John 16:14)

It has been a very full January for Pam and I (Will). We were so appreciative, the end of this January, to have funds covering close to all needs. The first time in so long. If you recall our miracle gift last February 2023. The 20,000 USD sent without knowing the need ... what trusting obedience ... truly a grandchildren story for years ahead!!! HMMMM and told in heaven even now???

As you were able to see in our Christmas newsletter, thanks to Mary and some friends; Christmas at Tiyamike was a joy and celebration. For those having read the past newsletters, our concern for our staff not having increase in wages since 2019 and the rising costs has been a known sadness carried only by knowing we have a Father who has authored Tiyamike. All done there was possible only thru his touch, nudge or however hearts moved to support the happenings. January 31 we received word the minimum wage of 50,000 kwacha was increased to 90,000 kwacha per month effective Feb 01, 2024. We are not in disagreement with the shocking increase in terms of needs for the employed. We have continually prayed for with hope for funds to allow our staff raises without govt decree. My lack of faith/trust kept us from doing it sooner?? We have always paid more than minimum wage without force. Of the 19,000,000 Malawians with many employed by businesses already hit by 22% devaluation 2 yrs ago and then 44% devaluation Nov 9, 2023. So yes, much needed increase as multiplied costs of living and wages staying the same... What will employers do to survive? How will the hundreds of thousands (million??) of minimum wage earners survive when let go? Please pray for Malawians and for wisdom for Government to make it thru this season without starvation and even violence. (Good soil for a revival !!!!)

An update on our fight with cancer, this has since Sept 2021 been a major impact on our lives and extended to Tiyamike as well. The last results indicated some increase in two smaller tumours and stability in the main one. Much better than it could have been!!! Pam is now on a (2 week) targeted therapy chemo program. She is challenged by a strong allergic reaction to one of the drugs. Apparently it indicates the treatment is effective and so prayer is welcome for her steadfastness and relief from the pain and rashes etc. We are supplementing with peptides and Ivermectin and the continued weekly Vitamin C IV's. We are strongly believing this is leading to "cancer free" with the late March Cat-scan to show the desired results. Mid-April both of us in Bangula ???

We are (gladly) trusting Holy Spirit for funds in the coming and even this month. We do not ever regret our lives since 2003 and are willingly a part of the credible ingathering of souls we believe is here!!! The HARVEST IS PLENTIFUL (Matthew 9 vs 37-38) There are many needs, prayer welcome. Viewing the following may well add much to your lives as it has ours.
