



POST-TREATMENT INSTRUCTIONS FOR EYEBROWS

Until your brows are completely healed, they will appear darker than you ultimately want them to be.

It will take approximately 30 days for your eyebrows to completely heal.

Be patient with this process

It is *normal* that your eyebrows feel sore to touch (initially), a little swollen or they begin to get itchy. **DO NOT RUB THE AREA**

- Every 4 hours for the first 24 hours you will need to gently pat or wipe the dried blood and serous fluid off your eyebrows with wet cotton balls.
- Using a Q-tip, apply a very thin layer of vaseline to each eyebrow 2-3 times a day until the initial healing is done. This may take between 7-10 days.
→ Keep them moist and do not let them dry out! ←
- Do not use any make-up on or near your eyebrows until the initial healing is done.

Some clients have chosen to use Ibuprofen or Tylenol for mild discomfort. Please check with your doctor before taking ANY medications over-the-counter or prescription.

*****Please contact your doctor immediately if you have prolonged pain and redness around your eyebrows or begin running a fever greater than 101 degrees*****
