The artificial arrangements that were at the graves at Saint Wenceslaus Cemetery are now located in a trailer, near the free standing shed between the church and school. The arrangements from Saint John the Baptist Cemetery are in a bin near the rectory garage. The arrangements from Saint Agnes Cemetery are located in a bin on the south side of the church. Please pick these up at your convenience. Anything left by the weekend of 06-07 July will be discarded. On 04 July, there will be Mass at Saint Wenceslaus at 8:30 am and at Saint John the Baptist church in Lesterville at 10:00 am. Also, there will be Mass on the first Saturday of every month to give honor to Mary; confessions will be heard from 8:00 until shortly before Mass at 9:00 am. I have not mentioned this in the past but we normally have adoration of the Blessed Sacrament on the first Friday of the month from 9:00 am until 2:00 pm when we pray the Litany of the Sacred Heart and conclude with benediction. You are most welcome to come and visit Jesus during this time. After a lot of litigation the body of Archbishop Fulton Sheen was moved from the Archdiocese of New York City was moved to the Diocese of Peoria, IL. This will help the canonisation (sainthood) cause to continue. Another development that happened this week was the announcement of Blessed John Henry Newman will be canonised a saint in the coming months. Blessed J.H. Newman was a convert from Anglicanism to Catholicism and his writings on theology and his sermons have been helpful in understanding what is called "The Development of Doctrine." I took a course on his writings and learned a lot about his life, conversion, and thought. There are some research papers that I have enjoyed and the two that I wrote for this course are among my favorites because it gave me time to re-read certain passages and pray with them as I wrote. His sermons from his time as an Anglican priest and as a Catholic priest are rather remarkable as well. You can learn more about him at www.newmanreader.org.

While I was in high school, I attended World Youth Day in Toronto in the summer of 2002 and I was introduced to a movement/community called L'Arche. This organization started in 1964 and it was founded by Jean Vanier, a man born in Canada and who recently died this year in Paris, France. This organization's mission statement is: "To make known the gifts of people with intellectual disabilities, working together toward a more humane society." This organization is rooted in the Catholic faith and it serves people of all faiths to help them use the gifts that God has given them. This organization has a special meaning to me because my sister has cerebral palsy (her health has continued to remain steady after the scare that we had shortly after I moved). When I was at World Youth Day, workers and volunteers from L'Arche helped people with disabilities act out scenes from the Bible and it was a very touching moment for me and those who got to watch it.
