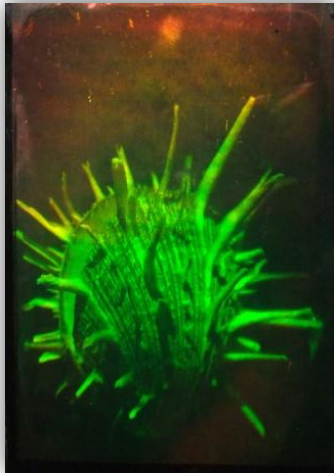

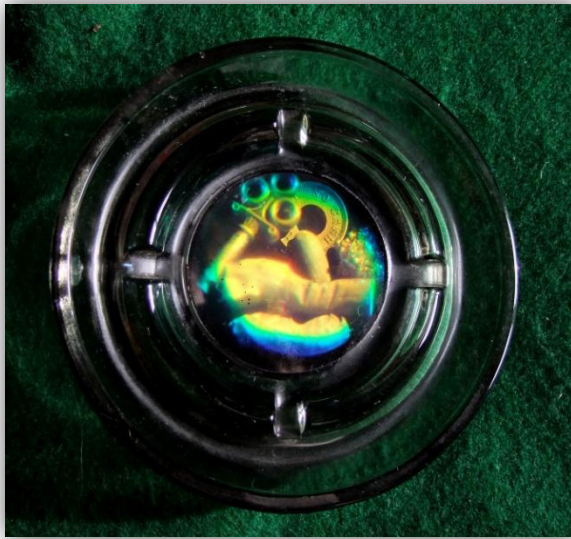

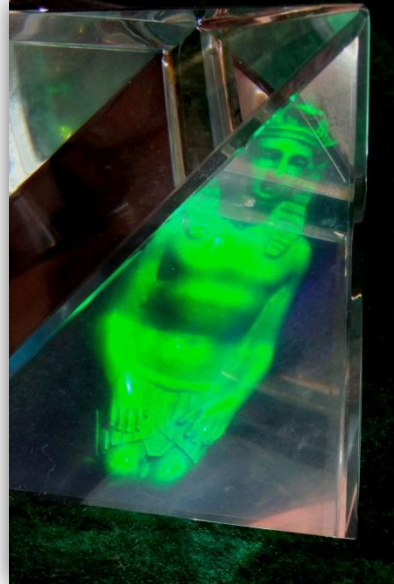

The pyramid and ashtray was made in 1993-94. Designer of the optical glass objects was Olga N. Shorohova. She is a member of Union of designers and member of Union of artists of Russia, graduated St Petersburg Academy of design by Mukhina, specialized in glass and ceramic. Now she lives in Luxemburg. The DCG holograms were made by Michael Shevtsov on Slavich PFG-04 DCG emulsion as well as the manufacturing of the pyramids and ashtray, the polishing and gluing the holograms. The *pharaoh figure* is from a private collection. Model of the *eagle* was made in 1990. This is the copy of the eagle which is located under the Petrovsky gate in P/P cathedral. With the help of Yuri Denisjuk, Shevtsov succeeded to manufacture a metallic figure in the Coin Yard (Monetnyi Dvor in P/P fortress).

A total of ten pyramids were made but only on ashtray (this one).
