

CITY WIDE SPRING CLEANUP

The city council has set Saturday, April 22, 2017, for the City Wide Spring Cleanup Day. A rain date has been set for April 29, 2017. All junk items can be disposed of, free of charge, by taking it to Cooley Sanitation on Main Street from 8:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. No tires, liquids, yard waste, garbage, batteries or construction pro-

ject materials will be accepted. White goods, such as washers, dryers, A.C.'s, stoves, refrigerators, freezers, water heaters, water softeners, dehumidifiers, furnaces, dish washers, light ballasts, microwaves, and humidifiers will require a disposal fee of \$10 per unit. Monitors, printers, and copiers will require a \$1 disposal fee. If

you are unable to get your junk items to Cooley's, they will pick up your items for a \$20 fee as long as they are placed outside of the house. This is a great time to get rid of unsightly junk that may have accumulated around our homes or back yards.

501 PINE STREET

The city has taken possession of the property at 501 Pine Street and will be demolishing it in March, 2017. The lot will be for sale once all expenses on the property have been obtained. The person purchasing the property must put a house back on the property within 1 year of purchase. It is a perfect lot for a single family home! ELMWOOD PARK SIDEWALK EXPANSION

A new sidewalk project at Elmwood Park that will connect the tennis courts to the shelter houses, pool, and high school baseball field will begin in the near future. GLEO MCCOMMONS SHELTER

A new shelter house has been installed at Elmwood Park by the little league baseball diamonds. This shelter was built using funds donated to the park by Gleo McCommons. MIDLAND GIS

The city has hired Midland GIS Solutions to do data collection, creation, and construction of a utility GIS program. They will be collecting data from the sanitary sewer utilities, water utilities, storm water utilities and water shut off valves. They will begin the work in March of 2017. They will have marked vehicles with their company logo so that you will be able to recognize them. If you see a flag by your shut off valve, it is for their use

CITY ORDINANCES TO REMEMBER AS WE ENTER SPRING...

GOLF CARTS - Golf carts may be operated upon the streets of the City by persons possessing a valid driver's license and a city permit. The annual fee for a permit is \$30.00 and is payable at the time the permit is granted. Permits are valid from January 1 through December 31. Golf carts may be operated on city streets only between sunrise and sunset and shall be equipped with a slow moving vehicle sign, a bicycle safety flag, a rearview mirror, and adequate brakes. No golf cart shall be used to carry more persons at one time than the number for which it is designed. Please operate your golf cart safely.

GRASS AND WEEDS - Please remember to maintain your lawn not to exceed six inches. This includes the rear yard as well as the front yard. To avoid additional expense to clean the storm sewers, please do not blow your grass clippings into the street. Any violations will be remedied by the city at the owner's expense. Any nuisance mowing not paid will be assessed to the county auditor and collected as property taxes. The purpose of keeping yards maintained at a uniform height is to beautify and preserve the appearance of the city in order to prevent unsightly, offensive or nuisance conditions. This shows visitors the pride we have in our city.

JUNK AND JUNK VEHICLES - Any vehicle that is unlicensed, lacks an engine or two or more wheels or other structural parts, or has a broken windshield is considered a "junk vehicle," and this includes unlicensed trailers. Any old scrap, batteries, trash, debris, dismantled vehicles, mattresses, discarded household goods, or dismantled appliances are considered "junk." Please be considerate of your neighbors and other citizens or visitors, and help make our city more attractive by discarding junk.

TREES - Property owners shall keep trees trimmed so that all branches will be at least twelve (12) feet above the surface of the street and eight (8) feet above the sidewalks. These requirements allow residents to utilize the sidewalks safely and allow for garbage trucks and other service vehicles to utilize the streets without damage to their vehicles or injury to their employees.

2017 AQUATIC CENTER SEASON

Planning for the 2017 pool season has started! The Reinbeck Park Board is currently seeking applications for pool managers, assistant managers, and lifeguards. Please stop by City Hall to apply or download the application off of the city website and turn in to City Hall.

Pool Passes are available at City Hall. When the pool opens, passes can be purchased there. Prices are \$3.00 for daily admission, \$75.00 for a single person pool pass, and \$150.00 for a family pool pass.

Did you know you can rent the pool for a private pool party? Private parties can be booked during times 5-6 pm or 8-10 pm. One-hour parties are \$80 and two-hour parties are \$150. Parties can be booked right now at City Hall and booked at the pool when it opens.
