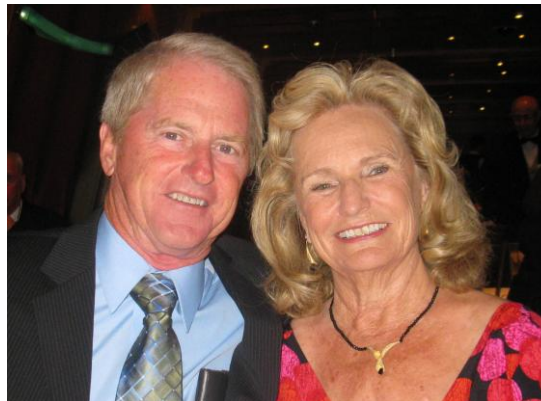

## Wood Mulches

Mulch helps retain valuable moisture, aids in weed control, and protects roots from extreme temperature variances. Provides an excellent accent around trees, shrubs and flowers. Use as a ground cover by spreading 2" to 4" on top of ground in desired area of use.

### All Natural Pine Mulch

Derived from East Texas Pine Trees.

Liked by Azaleas, Camellias, Roses and most evergreen shrubs and trees.

Gives a natural forest floor look to your garden area.



### All Natural Bark Nuggets

Derived from the outer bark of Pine Trees.

Liked by Azaleas, Camellias, Roses and most evergreen shrubs and trees.

Accents any landscape as a top dressing.

### Hardwood Mulch

Derived from East Texas Hardwood Trees.

Liked by most Annuals and Perennials.

Can be tilled or mixed into the soil to improve the texture.



### All Natural Cedar Mulch

Derived from Cedar Trees.

Resins in cedar mulch emit a pleasant scent.

### Composted Cow/Humus

Derived from local farms and ranches.

Liked by vegetable gardens and any flower garden in need of organic material. Added to sandy soils, it improves water-holding capacity. Added to clay soils, it aerates the soil and improves water-holding capacity.

Mix well into soil at desired depth. For flowers and vegetables not less than 4" to 6". Transplanting trees and shrubs, mix 4" to 6" larger than the root ball.

Can be used with other Natural Earth products such as topsoil, pine mulch and hardwood mulch to create the soil texture desired by the gardener's plants.



### Top Soil

Derived from East Texas' finest loam soil.

A special blend of sandy loam soil and Natural Earth's oldest available humus creating mother nature's topsoil.

Use to fill in low spots, plant sod, build up flowerbeds and vegetable gardens.

Meets your lawn patching needs and improves most native soils.
