

# Beginner A-Line Skirt Class

Please NO sewing machines the first 2 days of class. There should be time to address questions on particular models another day.

## Required items:

- Notepaper/pen
- Enough pre-washed and dried non-slippery, non-stretchy, preferably cotton fabric to complete the skirt in your size
  - for waist measurements under 30", 1 yard of 45"-wide fabric (need ½ yard more if the fabric has a design that needs to be "right-side up")
  - for waist measurements over 30", 1 ½ yard of 45" wide fabric
  - for 60" wide fabric, refer to the Butterick Pattern 4461 envelope (remember your size in patterns is likely to be 3 or more sizes larger than your ready-to-wear size. Use body measurements.)
- Matching thread
- 7-inch (or longer) invisible zipper
- Optional ribbon trim – refer to Butterick Pattern 4461 envelope for amounts (not needed until at least day 4 of class)

## Provided items:

- ✓ Butterick Pattern 4461
- ✓ Interfacing
- ✓ Hook & eye (optional)

The following items are not required, as the sewing classroom is well-equipped, but you may choose to have your own:

- Small see-through ruler (approx 2"x18" and flexible)
- Scissors and/or rotary cutter
- Glass or metal head Pins & Pin cushion
- Seam ripper
- Hand sewing needles
- Bees' wax or Thread Heaven
- Tape Measure
- Thread clippers
- Magnifier glasses
- Supply bin/tote
- Hem gauge
- Tailor's chalk or other marking tool(s)
