HIBBARD CHARGES INTO WINNER'S CIRCLE FOR 3rd TIME

URBEN BECOMES TOUR'S NEWEST CHAMPION

HIBBARD BECOMES 3-TIME CHAMPION

Billy Hibbard, already a 2-time tour champion, charged into the GISBT Winner's Circle for the 3rd time at the opening event of the 2019-2020 campaign. The stocky stroker remained patient, and closed the deal by storming from behind, overcoming a 125-pin deficit over the final 4 games of match play. The 21 year-old from Mukwonago, Wisconsin was almost unstoppable in match play, averaging 232.37 for his 8 matches, winning 7 and losing just once; that came during a final game 202-187 position round loss to eventual runner-up Dakota Solonka.

Over the past 3 seasons, the 21 year-old has gained a reputation as one of the tour's top shotmakers, and that fine form continued at the season opener. This month marked Hibbard's 17th trip into the match play finals, and the \$350 championship check boosted his career earnings on tour to \$3,645.

Hibbard joins an impressive list of 3-time GISBT champions, and in the 273 event history of the Greater Iowa Scholarship Bowling Tour, only 16 boys have accumulated more than 3 titles during their careers. For his 16 games, the champion averaged 226.12. Congratulations, Billy!

QUALIFYING LEADER SOLONKA LANDS RUNNER-UP SPOT

Dakota Solonka was this month's runner-up; he earned a \$225 scholarship. The powerful 2-hander from Indianapolis, Indiana grabbed the lead after game #3 in qualifying, eventually leading by 38 pins heading into match play. He continued to lead until eventual champ Billy Hibbard grabbed a 1-pin advantage with 2 games remaining. Hibbard's 245-213 win in game #7 put Solonka in arrears by 63 pins, and despite turning the tables with a 202-187 win in the position round, Solonka was forced to settle for the runner-up prize, closing the final margin to just 17 pins.

The 20 year-old 2-hander from Indianapolis, Indiana was one of 4 past tour champions in this month's boy's finals field. This marked the 4th match play appearance of his career.

80 COMPETITORS KICK OFF SEASON # 28

A stellar field of 80 competitors kicked off the 2019-2020 season of Greater Iowa Scholarship Bowling Tour competition. The contingent included a dozen past champions, as well as 18 players making their GISBT debut. Welcome to all of our new members, as well as our returning players.

PAST CHAMP DODGE TAKES 3rd

Brandon Dodge turned in a solid performance at the season opener by finishing 3rd. Dodge, a right-hander from North Bend, Nebraska earned a \$200 scholarship. The 20 year-old, appearing in the 4th finals of his tour career, was steady all day, with the lowest of his 16 games being just 192.

REID PLACES 4th IN TOUR DEBUT

Clayton Reid celebrated his 18th birthday by making an impressive tour debut at this month's event. The right-hander turned in a consistent performance, and it led to a 4th place finish; he won a \$175 award for his day's work. Reid turned 18 on the day of this year's Saturday Kick-off Classic. Most competitors agreed that Reid is definitely a player who bears watching in future tour events.

MILLER FIRES 300 ON WAY TO 5th PLACE SHOWING

Evan Miller, 19, was this month's 5th place finisher. The Sioux Falls, South Dakota native cranked out a crowd-captivating 300 game in his qualifying round, and that helped him surge up the leaderboard and into the 3rd tour finals of his career. The right-hander was returning to the scene of his GISBT tour victory – a title he captured back in January 2018. He won a \$150 scholarship by virtue of his performance.

KYLLONEN FINISHES 6th

Ryan Kyllonen finished 6th in Cedar Rapids; the 2-hander from Bethel, Minnesota was one of 3 first time finalists in this month's boy's finals; all 3 were making their tour debuts as well. The powerful 19 year-old hauled in a \$125 scholarship for his efforts.

BLOOMQUIST 7th IN FINALS RETURN

Darin Bloomquist, 19, returned to the GISBT finals for the 2nd time in his promising career this month. He would go on to finish 7th, taking home a \$110 award for his performance.

JONES TAKES 8th

William Jones rounded out this month's finals field with an 8th place performance. The talented right-hander was one of 3 first-time finalists in this month's boy's field. Jones, from Anoka, Minnesota, earned a \$100 scholarship for his finish.

Alex Diercks, from Cedar Rapids, Iowa, took home the \$55 scholarship by firing a 280 game in his qualifying round, which earned him this month's high game out of the money award.

**URBEN SECURES FIRST TOUR VICTORY
BECOMES 84th DIFFERENT GIRL'S CHAMPION**

URBEN BECOME'S TOUR'S NEWEST CHAMPION

Heading into this month's position round match, just 35 pins separated Cassidy Courey and Sydney Urben from the championship. Courey, one of the tour's top stars over the past 3 seasons, had already collected 3 tour victories, while Urben, making just her 2nd appearance on tour, was looking for title #1. In the final position round match, Urben defeated the 3-time champ convincingly 222-153.

Urben was impressive from the start, averaging 211.50 for her 8-game qualifying block. She garnered this month's High Qualifier medal, and established a 37-pin lead heading into match play. There, she and eventual runner-up Cassidy Courey traded the lead back-and-forth before the eventual champion won a decisive position round match to lock up the championship.

The spoils of victory included a \$275 championship scholarship, the winner's plaque and a permanent place on Champion's Row, as she became the 84th different girl's champion in the 28-season history of the GISBT. For her 14 games, Urben averaged 209.71. Congratulations, Sydney!

3-TIME WINNER COUREY FINISHES 2nd

Over the past 3 seasons, Cassidy Courey has asserted herself as one of the tour's brightest stars, amassing a collection of 3 titles, 17 match play finals, and 3 consecutive berths on the GISBT girl's All Star Team. The 20 year-old from Brooklyn Center, Minnesota began the 2019-2020 season with another stellar performance, garnering a runner-up finish, and along with it a \$175 scholarship.

This marked Courey's 4th career runner-up showing on tour to go alongside her 3 GISBT victories.

4-TIME CHAMP PALMER PLACES 3rd

Bailey Palmer staged a comeback late in qualifying, and it enabled her to sneak into the 24th match play finals of her illustrious career. Once there, she posted the top match play score, and the best match play record, a glossy 5-1 ledger that enabled her to charge from 6th place into 3rd place. The 4-time GISBT winner received a \$150 scholarship for her performance.

NELSON 4th IN GISBT DEBUT

Addy Nelson is a fresh face on the GISBT scene. The talented right-hander from Gregory, South Dakota made her tour debut a successful one by finishing 4th at this year's season opener in Cedar Rapids. The 18 year-old hauled away a \$125 scholarship for her day's work.

HESS CLAIMS 5th

2-time GISBT champion Megan Hess secured 5th place at the season opener. Appearing in the 8th match play finals of her career, the right-hander from Granger, Iowa claimed a \$110 scholarship for her day's work.

MOORE 6th IN 3rd FINALS APPEARANCE

At last season's Tournament of Champion's, Rachel Moore was awarded the Rising Star Award, presented to a promising young player on tour. This month, the slender right-hander from Keokuk, Iowa continued her blossoming career by qualifying for her 3rd match play finals. Moore, just 14 years old, took home a \$100 scholarship for her efforts.

This month's high game out of the money was awarded to newcomer Ayra Aminuddin, from Malaysia. She rolled a 234 in her qualifying round, which helped garner the \$55 high game out of the money scholarship.
