

Wagon Train Rules Form PLEASE READ RULES FOR THIS RIDE CAREFULLY

- Ride ribbon is required to be displayed on each person on the train -\$10.00 per person
- 2. <u>NO</u> open display of drinking of alcoholic beverages
- 3. <u>NO</u> profanity allowed! This is a family event with children present.
- 4. <u>NO</u> riding LEFT of the center line of pavement.
- 5. Respect the private property of others and **DO NOT** ride in fields or yards.
- 6. The Trail Boss reserves the right to dismiss anyone due to:
 - a. Disorderly conduct, drunken behavior or abusive language
 - b. Horse that is NOT under control
 - c. Intoxication <u>Use of alcohol UNDER THE AGE OF 21 is NOT</u> <u>allowed!!!</u> <u>NO EXCEPTIONS!!</u>
 - d. Not Following the rules
- 7. The RIDE SCOUTS are to be obeyed at all times. The only rider behind the Rear Scout is to have the Rear Scout's permission.
- 8. No passing the lead wagon.
- 9. Stallions must be double tied.
- 10. Horses that kick must display a **RED** ribbon in their tail. Ask Trail Boss for ribbon.
- 11. All breakdowns are to be reported to a Scout.
- 12. No littering. (If you pack it out, pack it back in)
- 13. No firearms without a legal permit.
- 14. Be ready to pull out at 9:30 am each morning.
- 15. **Current Coggins** is required on each horse. You may want to carry a copy with you as horses are not to be on public right of ways without proof of a Negative Coggins. (1999 NC State Law)
