

# **ARNOLD P. TROST**

## **1912 - 1995**

Arnold P. Trost, 83, long-time Pinnebog area businessman, passed away Thursday, Dec. 28 at Huron Memorial Hospital after a brief illness.

He was born June 8, 1912 in Detroit, son of the late Julia and Matilda (Witt) Trost. He was united in marriage to Irene M. Leybourne in South Bend, IN in 1932. She preceded him in death in 1964. He married Evelyn (Stewart) Drummond on June 25, 1966 in Cassville.

Mr. Trost moved to the Cassville area in 1953 and worked as a metal machinist. He opened Huron Metal Industries in 1966 near Pinnebog, retiring in 1985.

Surviving are his wife, Evelyn; three sons, Robert (Linda) Trost of Dearborn, Ross (Joyce) Trost of New Baltimore and Larry (Betty) Trost of Kanosha, Wt; two daughters, Joan (Skip) Kostel of Utica and Carol (Alfred) Block of Reese; a stepson, Duane (Shirley) Drummond of Crosswell and a stepdaughter, Carolyn (Jim) Pedler of Cassville; 22 grandchildren; 12 great-grandchildren and one great-great-grandchild.

He was preceded in death by a grandson, Michael Trost; three brothers, Clarence, Harold and Arthur and two sisters, Sabina Gower and Verna Statler.
