

2/4/2019

Deputy Ridley and Deputy Copley responded to a call of shots fired in the Beallsville area. Upon arrival it was determined that the sounds were coming from a well pad. DS1 was contacted and came to the scene. The noise changed from loud bangs and sounded like a leak. After a while, the safety mechanism kicked on and all of the sounds stopped. DS1 is following up on this incident.

A wallet was found and brought into the Sheriff's Office. Deputy Ridley located the owner and returned it.

Deputy Blamble responded to a welfare check in Jackson Township. Deputy Blamble contacted the subject and everything was ok.

Deputy Norman assisted a disabled motorist on State Route 145 in Sunbury Township.

Sgt. Smith investigated an abandoned truck left on Straight Fork Road near State Route 26. The vehicle was towed out of the roadway.

Deputy Norman performed a welfare check in Adams Township on an elderly person. The person was located and found to be fine.

Sgt. Smith patrolled State Route 78 in Center Township regarding a call of a possible disabled motor vehicle. However, the vehicle was not located and the roadway was clear.

2/5/2019

Deputy Ridley responded to an injured animal call in the Fly area. The caller stated that a coyote was on her porch and wouldn't leave. She believed that it was injured and needed put down. Deputy Ridley was unable to make contact with the animal.

Sgt. Smith investigated a two-vehicle accident on State Route 7 in Duffy. The driver was cited for failure to control after backing off State Route 7 striking a parked car. A report was taken.

2/6/2019

Sgt. Yonley initiated a traffic stop on State Route 7 in Jackson Township. During the course of the investigation, a loaded firearm and set of brass knuckles were discovered in the vehicle. The suspect was arrested and taken to the Monroe County Jail.

Deputy Schuerman was dispatched to a possible mental call in the Wilson area. Deputy Schuerman spoke to the male caller and after running his information through dispatch, there was a warrant for his arrest. The subject was arrested and transported to the Monroe County Jail.

2/8/2019

The male, Joe Byler and Robert Combs were arrested for Inducing panic and Obstructing Official Business and transported to the Monroe County Jail.

Deputy Blamble responded to the Sardis area in reference to oil and gas trucks parking on property they did not have permission to park on. The trucks were asked to leave the property and it was resolved without incident.

Deputy Ridley responded to State Route 556 in reference to a crash without injuries. Both vehicles were able to be removed and information was obtained for a report to be completed.
