

## Board Meeting June 5, 2019

Major items for discussion:

EPTEMBER 20<u>19 Volume 45 issue</u>

Beginning in 2007, the late <u>Andrew Tallon</u> worked at Vassar College in the Department of Art.<sup>[4]</sup> Tallon described himself as "obsessed" with Notre-Dame de Paris. He used laser scanners to map the interior and exterior of the Notre-Dame, as well as 45 other historical buildings.<sup>[3]</sup> Tallon began scanning Notre-Dame in 2010 with Paul Blaer, going over the interior and exterior of the building. All told, they repositioned the scanner fifty times for comprehensive detail, resulting in over one billion points of data.<sup>[5]</sup> After the <u>Notre-Dame de Paris fire</u> in 2019, Tallon's work mapping the building's interior was cited as a potential resource for planned reconstruction.

- 1. The end of June will be one year with NSPE. The Board wants to have a whole year of working with them before having a review. One of the items for discussion is the lag time for receiving dues.
- 2. The standard Specs for Water and Sewer Design will be released by the end of the year.
- 3. To generate more income, the Board is considering more seminars. They are looking for regional topics.
- 4. For the Work Plan They are looking for input from the Chapters regarding what we would like to see offered. Staff is looking for suggestions on possible speakers.
- 5. Government Affairs The Capital plan passed but the actual project need to be worked out. The Engineering Practice Act passed. This is for 10 years and the PE Board was protected.
- 6. ISPE Convention Registration is open. The boot camp will be worked on after the convention. The student App still looks like it will be available at the convention. The PDH tracking App has hit a snag and might not be usable in its present form.
- 7. The ISPE budget was approved.
